LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993 – PROCLAMATION

MARIE BASHIR, Governor

I, Professor MARIE BASHIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, on the recommendation of the Minister for Local Government after considering the results of a public inquiry concerning Warringah Council, and with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of sections 255 and 256 of the Local Government Act 1993, do, by this my Proclamation:

- (a) declare all civic offices in relation to the Warringah Council to be vacant;
- (b) appoint Richard Persson as Administrator of the Warringah Council;
and
- (c) order that the term of the Administrator is until 1 August 2005.
