ROAD TRANSPORT ACT 2013

ORDER

(LS) MARIE BASHIR, Governor

- I, Professor The Honourable Marie Bashir, A.C., C.V.O., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the Road Transport Act 2013 (the Act), do, by this Order, approve the following types of devices being designed for uses described hereunder:
 - 1. Approved traffic enforcement device approved for speed measurement, designed to measure the speed at which a vehicle is travelling (whether or not the vehicle concerned is also photographed) in accordance with the terms of section 134 (1) (a) of the Act;
 - Approved traffic enforcement device approved for excess speed imaging, designed to photograph a vehicle that is driven in excess of a speed limit applicable to a length of road in accordance with the terms of section 134 (1) (b) of the Act.

Type of device:

The multiple use device, TraffiStar S392M.

Road Transport Act 2013

Order

Section 134 of the Road Transport Act 2013 provides that a device may be approved for use as an approved device or combinations of types of devices for the purpose of 2 or more uses, by order of the Governor and published in the New South Wales Government Gazette.

The attached order approves the *TraffiStar S392M* for the purpose of multiple use functions.
