GAME AND FERAL ANIMAL CONTROL INSTRUMENT OF DELEGATION (No. 1) 2014

under the

Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002

1. Name of Instrument

This Instrument is the Game and Feral Animal Control Instrument of Delegation (No. 1) 2014.

2. Commencement

This Instrument commences on the day on which it is signed and will remain in force until it is revoked, whether in whole or in part.

3. Interpretation

(1) In this Instrument

Act means the Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002.

Regulation means the Game and Feral Animal Control Regulation 2012, made under the Act.

- (2) The summary of function delegated in Column 2 of the Schedules is only for general explanation and does not limit the delegation of functions under the provision identified in Column 1 of the Schedules.
- (3) Unless otherwise defined in this Instrument, words and expressions that are defined in the Act have the same meaning in this Instrument.

4. Revocation of Game and Feral Animal Control Act (Delegation) (No. 2) 2013

Pursuant to section 53A of the Act, the Instrument titled "Game and Feral Animal Control Act (Delegation) (No. 2) 2013", dated 19 December 2013, is revoked, as is any instrument of delegation revived as a result of this revocation.

5. Delegation of functions

- (1) Pursuant to section 53A of the Act, the functions conferred or imposed on the Regulatory Authority under the section of the Act specified in Column 1 of Schedule A are delegated to the person who from time to time holds, occupies or performs the duties of the position in the Department of Primary Industries (being an office within the Department of Trade and Investment, Regional Infrastructure and Services) described opposite in Column 3 of Schedule A.
- (2) Pursuant to section 53A of the Act, the functions conferred or imposed on the Regulatory Authority under the clause of the Regulation specified in Column 1 of Schedule B are delegated to the person who from time to time holds, occupies or performs the duties of the position in the Department of Primary Industries (being an office within the Department of Trade and Investment, Regional Infrastructure and Services) described opposite in Column 3 of Schedule B.
- (3) The delegation of a function by this Instrument includes the power to amend or repeal anything done in the exercise of that function and to exercise any other function that is incidental to the delegated function.





Proposed Cy-Près Scheme Relating to the Estate of the Late Norman Keith Brown

SECTION 9 (1) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993 permits the application of property cy-près where the spirit of the original trust can no longer be implemented.

By his will dated on or about 17 August 2008, the Testator Norman Keith Brown bequeathed the residue of his estate in three equal shares to

- (1) Mr Alan Robert Brown, the Administrator of the will and trustee of the Trust,
- (2) 'The Cancer Research Foundation' and
- (3) 'The Heart and Vascular Research Foundation'.

Of the latter two shares no entity of either names exists. The nearest named charities are the Australian Cancer Research Foundation (ACRF) and the National Heart Foundation of Australia (NSW Division) (NHFA).

Following discussions between these two existing Foundations and the Administrator and the Testator's other children, agreement has been reached, formalised in a Deed, regarding the proposed distribution of the estate into six equal shares with a share each to each Foundation.

The Solicitor General, as delegate of the Attorney General in Charitable Trusts Act 1993 matters, has determined that there is a charitable trust for the relief of the impotent and that the gift in the will of Norman Keith Brown evinces a general charitable intent. While the agreement reached would mean that half of the money bequeathed by the Testator to charitable purposes would not be going to charity, given the competing claims to the estate and in the interests of avoiding lengthy and costly litigation, the Solicitor General considers the agreement between the various parties to be appropriate.

The Solicitor General is of the view that this is an appropriate matter in which the Attorney General should

approve a cy-près scheme under section 12 (1) (a) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993. The cy-près scheme will permit the trust property be applied cy-près to allow the Australian Cancer Research Foundation and the National Heart Foundation of Australia each to receive a one-sixth share of the Testator's estate.

Take note that within one month after the publication of this notice any person may make representations or suggestions to the Attorney General in respect of the proposed scheme. Representations should be made to the Director, Justice Legal, NSW Department of Police and Justice, PO Box 6, Sydney NSW 2001.

Cy-Près Scheme Relating to the Mearns Massie Endowment Fund

SECTION 9 (1) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993 permits the application of property cy-près where the spirit of the original trust can no longer be implemented.

By his will dated 5 December 1935, William Mearns Massie ('the testator') of Dulwich Hill, bequeathed the residue of his estate to 'pay the net income thereof to the Trustees of the Presbyterian Church of Australia in the State of New South Wales in trust to apply such income in the purchase of food and clothing for the orphans in the Burnside Orphans Home (or such of them as the Governing body of the said home shall from time to time nominate) and for no other purpose..'

As at 17 May 2012, the value of the Mearns Massie Endowment Fund ('the Fund') was \$14,273.55. The NSW Trustee and Guardian ('the trustee') applied for a cy-près scheme under section 12 of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993 in respect of the Fund to permit the Funds to be transferred to the Uniting Church in Australia Property Trust (NSW) and the income used for the purchase of food and clothing for the children residing in the Burnside Homes.

As there was a charitable trust evidenced by the relief of orphans housed in Burnside Orphan Homes and as it appeared that the original trust purposes had ceased to be suitable and effective because there are no longer any orphanages (or, it appears, any need for orphanages) in New South Wales, a cy-près scheme was ordered by the Attorney General, which took effect in June 2013.

The NSWTAG notified the Attorney General in 2014 that an additional sum of \$30,000 had been located by it, which belonged to the Mearns Massie Trust Fund. The scheme approved in respect of the sum of \$14,273.55 does not apply to this additional sum. It is therefore necessary that a further scheme be ordered to cover the additional sum.

As delegate of the Attorney General in Charitable Trusts Act 1993 matters, I have determined that this is an appropriate matter in which the Attorney General should, by Order, establish a further scheme under section 12 of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993 and I have accepted a recommendation that a scheme be established in relation to the additional sum of

\$30,000, in the same terms as the original sum. This scheme permitted the Uniting Church in Australia Property Trust (NSW) (ARBN 134 487 095) to be appointed trustee in place of the current trustee and the application of the income of the Fund cy-près for the purchase of food and clothing for the children residing in the residential care homes operated by UnitingCare Burnside.

I hereby Order, under section 12 (1) (a) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993, that a cy-près scheme be established in relation to the additional sum of \$30,000, in the same terms as the scheme for the application of the original sum, namely the application of the income of the Fund to be applied cy-près for the purchase of food and clothing for the children residing in the residential care homes operated by UnitingCare Burnside.

This Order will take effect 21 days after its publication in the *New South Wales Government Gazette*, in accordance with section 16 (2) of the Charitable Trusts Act 1993.

2. Commencement

3. Exemption

This Exemption is made by the WorkCover Authority of New South Wales following an application from the Construction Hoist Industry Body.

This Exemption applies to persons to the extent that those persons who hold a high risk work licence for the operation of a Personnel and Materials Hoist also operate a Materials Hoist. Those persons who hold a Personnel and Materials Hoist high risk work licence are exempt from the requirements of Clauses 81 Licence required to carry out high risk work and 85 Evidence of licence, of the Regulation, to hold a high risk work licence to operate a Materials Hoist, subject to the conditions in the Schedule to this Exemption.

4. Definitions

For the purposes of this Exemption:

Regulation means the Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011.

Materials Hoist, used in this Schedule, means:
