## SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION ACT 1989

Notice under Section 5<br>Remaking of the Aboriginal Land Rights Regulation 2002

SECTION 10 (2) (a) of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989, provides that a statutory rule published on or after 1 September 1990, is to be repealed and 'remade' every five years.

The Aboriginal Land Rights Regulation 2002 (ALRR), which is a statutory rule, is currently being reviewed for remaking on 1 September 2014. The draft remade ALRR and a statement on the background to the proposed remaking (the Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS)) have been uploaded to the Aboriginal Affairs website: http://www.aboriginalaffairs. nsw.gov.au/ for consultation with the community and stakeholders. If you do not have access to the internet, or would prefer to receive a paper copy of the RIS, please contact one of the Officers below, who will arrange for a paper copy of the relevant documentation to be sent to you.

As part of the consultation process for the remaking of the ALRR interested persons and groups are invited to read both the RIS and the draft remade ALRR and provide any comments and submissions on the draft ALRR by mail or email to the contact officers below within 28 days of the publication of this notice.

Please note that this repeal and remaking of the ALRR is a statutory process independent of and separate to the current five yearly statutory review of the Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983 (ALRA).
