HERITAGE ACT 1977

INTERIM HERITAGE ORDER NO. 121

Former BHP Medical Centre, Master Mechanic's Office and Pattern Store, David Barker Road and Selwyn Street, Mayfield North

PURSUANT to section 24 of the Heritage Act 1977, and having received advice from the Heritage Council of NSW, I, the Minister for Heritage consider that on further inquiry or investigation, the following item may be found to be of State or local heritage significance, and I therefore by this Order:

- (i) make an interim heritage order in respect of the item of the environmental heritage specified or described in Schedule 'A'; and
- (ii) declare that the interim heritage order shall apply to the curtilage or site of such item, being the land described in Schedule 'B'.
- (iii) specify that this Order remains in force for a period of 12 months from date of publication of this Order in the Gazette.

The former Medical Centre, the former Master Mechanic's Office and the former Pattern Store, including 5 metres from the physical edge of the buildings, within Lot 35 of DP 1191723 in Parish of Newcastle, County of Northumberland.
