INTERIM HERITAGE ORDER NO. 124

UNDERCLIFF HOUSE REMAINS
69 PITTWATER ROAD, MANLY

In pursuance of Section 24 of the Heritage Act 1977 (NSW), I, the Minister for Heritage, consider that on further inquiry or investigation, the following item may be found to be of State or local heritage significance, and I therefore by this Order:

- (i) make an interim heritage order in respect of the item of the environmental heritage specified or described in Schedule 'A'; and
- (ii) declare that the interim heritage order shall apply to the curtilage or site of such item, being the land described in Schedule 'B'; and
- (iii) specify that this Order remains in force for a period of 12 months from the date of publication of this Order in the *Gazette*.
