ELECTRICITY NETWORK ASSETS (AUTHORISED TRANSACTIONS) ACT 2015

Order under clause 6 (1) of Schedule 7

I, Gladys Berejiklian, Treasurer of the State of New South Wales, pursuant to clause 6 (1) of Schedule 7 of the *Electricity Network Assets (Authorised Transactions) Act 2015* order that the electricity network SOC known as TransGrid be converted into a corporation constituted as a Ministerial Holding Corporation with the name Electricity Transmission Ministerial Holding Corporation.

This Order takes effect immediately after completion of the authorised transaction of TransGrid's electricity network assets under the *Electricity Network Assets (Authorised Transactions) Act 2015*.
