QUARANTINE AREA (FOOTROT IN SHEEP AND GOATS) NOTIFICATION 2015

under the

STOCK DISEASES ACT 1923

I, Niall Blair, Minister for Primary Industries, in pursuance of section 10 of the *Stock Diseases Act 1923* on account of the presence or suspected presence of the disease 'Footrot in sheep and goats' on land specified in Schedule 1, make the following notification.

Explanatory note

This Notification is made under section 10 of the *Stock Diseases Act 1923*. The object of this Notification is to declare the land described in Schedule 1 to be a quarantine area on account of the presence or suspected presence of the disease 'Footrot in sheep and goats'.

QUARANTINE AREA (FOOTROT IN SHEEP AND GOATS) NOTIFICATION 2015

STOCK DISEASES ACT 1923

1 Name of Instrument

This Instrument is the Quarantine Area (Footrot in Sheep and Goats) Notification 2015.

2 Commencement

This Instrument commences on the day on which it published in the NSW Government Gazette.

3 Interpretation

Unless otherwise defined in this Instrument, words and expressions that are defined in the Act have the same meaning in this Instrument.

4 Declaration of Quarantine Area


The area described in Schedule 1, which is within the State of New South Wales, is declared to be a quarantine area on account of the presence or suspected presence of Footrot in sheep and goats.

Note: Section 20C of the *Stock Diseases Act 1923* makes provision for various offences, including an offence to move or cause or permit the movement of stock into, within or out of a quarantine area. The maximum penalty for this offence is 100 penalty units (currently \$11,000).

Schedule 1 Quarantine Area

The following areas of crown land within the Parish of Jettiba in the County of Wellesley:

- 1. all areas of crown land shown in red in the map below, and
- 2. all areas of crown land shown in blue in the map below that fall within the boundary fence of the property known as 'Shirley', Nimmitabel NSW 2631.
