SENATORS' ELECTIONS ACT 1903

Order under Section 3

WHEREAS in section 3 of the *Senators' Elections Act 1903*, it is provided that, for the purpose of elections of Senators for New South Wales of the Parliament of the Commonwealth, the Governor may, from time to time, by order published in the Gazette, fix the dates for the issue of the writ; the close of the electoral rolls; the nomination of the candidates; the polling; and the return of the writ: NOW, therefore, I General The Honourable David Hurley AC DSC (Ret'd), Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and pursuant to the provisions of section 3 of the said Act, do, by this order, fix the following dates for the undermentioned purposes, viz.,

The issue of the writ.....16 May 2016
The close of the electoral rolls23 May 2016
The nomination of the candidates 9 June 2016
The polling..... 2 July 2016
The return of the writno later than 8 August 2016
