RICE MARKETING ACT 1983

PROCLAMATION

Vesting of Rice in the Rice Marketing Board for the State of New South Wales

His Excellency General The Honourable David Hurley AC DSC (Ret'd)
Governor

I, General The Honourable David Hurley AC DSC (Ret'd), Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council and pursuant to section 56 of the *Rice Marketing Act 1983*, do hereby:

1. revoke the Proclamation entitled “Vesting of Rice in the Rice Marketing Board for the State of New South Wales”, dated 16 January 2013 and published in the New South Wales Government Gazette No.6 on 25 January 2013; and
2. declare that rice shall on and from the date of the publication of this Proclamation in the New South Wales Government Gazette be divested from the producers thereof and become absolutely vested in and be the property of the Rice Marketing Board for the State of New South Wales (“the Board”);
3. declare that upon any rice coming into existence within the period on and from the date of the publication of this Proclamation in the New South Wales Government Gazette to 30 June 2022, it shall become absolutely vested in and be the property of the Board; and
4. pursuant to section 56(5)(c) of the *Rice Marketing Act 1983*, authorise the Director-General of the Department of Primary Industries within the Department of Industry to make determinations and apply measures as to, the possible development of the New South Wales rice industry outside of the Murray and Riverina areas, including directing the Board to conduct or commission relevant investigations and produce relevant reports.
