LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993

EXTENSION OF THE PERIOD IN WHICH A BY-ELECTION IS TO BE HELD FOR A VACANCY ON WOLLONDILLY SHIRE COUNCIL

I, the Hon. Gabrielle Upton MP, Minister for Local Government, am of the opinion that it would be impractical or inconvenient to hold a by-election pursuant to section 292 of the *Local Government Act 1993* (the Act) for the vacancy on the Wollondilly Shire Council caused by the resignation from civic office of the former Councillor Ray Law.

Pursuant to section 293 of the Act, I appoint Saturday 28 October 2017, as the date on which that by-election is to be held.
