Lord Howe Island Board 2018 Election of Four (4) Members to the Board

Election Notice

Pursuant to section 9A(b) of the *Lord Howe Island Act 1953 No. 39*, the Electoral Commissioner for New South Wales shall conduct an election for the purpose of determining the Islanders to be elected to the Lord Howe Island Board pursuant to section 4(3)(a) of the Act.

Nominations

Nominations are hereby invited on and from Friday, 5 January 2018 to elect four (4) members to the Board.

To be eligible for nomination, a candidate must be an Islander as defined in the Lord Howe Island Act and be enrolled as an elector for the election.

A candidate at an election shall be nominated by at least 2 persons (other than the candidate) who -

- (a) are enrolled as electors for the election; and
- (b) have not, by that nomination and any other previous nomination in respect of the election, nominated more candidates than there are persons to be elected, i.e. four (4) persons.

Lodgement of Nominations

Completed Nomination Forms must be received by the Returning Officer, NSW Electoral Commission by **no later than 12.00 noon, Friday 19 January 2018**.

Nomination forms can only be lodged with the Returning Officer at the NSW Electoral Commission:

Any defect in a nomination must be rectified by the candidate prior to the close of nominations **12.00 noon, Friday 19 January 2018**. A candidate may only withdraw a nomination in writing so as to be received by the Returning Officer, prior to the close of nominations.

Should the election be contested, a draw to determine the order of candidates' names on the ballot paper will be conducted at 2.00pm, Friday 19 January 2018 by the Deputy Returning Officer, Lord Howe Island Board Administration Office. Candidates or their representatives are invited to witness the draw.

Voting

If more than the required number of nominations are received, a poll will be held between the hours of:- **8.00am and 6.00pm on Thursday 8 February 2018**.

WASTE AVOIDANCE AND RESOURCE RECOVERY (CONTAINER DEPOSIT SCHEME) REGULATION 2017

(clause 22 (a))

Order determining application fees for container approvals

I, Barry Buffier, Chair and Chief Executive Officer of the Environment Protection Authority (EPA), on behalf of the EPA and by this Order:

Revocation

1. Revoke the Order under clause 22 of the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery (Container Deposit Scheme) Regulation 2017* (the Regulation) made by me on 15 August 2017 and published in the NSW Government Gazette No 89 of 18 August 2017 at page 4419.

Application fee

2. Determine the application fee for a container approval under clause 22 (a) of the Regulation is \$80.

Application fee after 40 applications

3. Determine the application fee for a container approval under clause 22 (a) of the Regulation is \$0 for any subsequent application made by a supplier who has already made 40 applications for container approvals in the same financial year.

In this Order:

financial year means the period from 1 July to the next following 30 June.

supplier means a supplier who supplies 2.5 million beverage containers or less in the financial year immediately preceding the financial year for which the application for a container approval is made.
