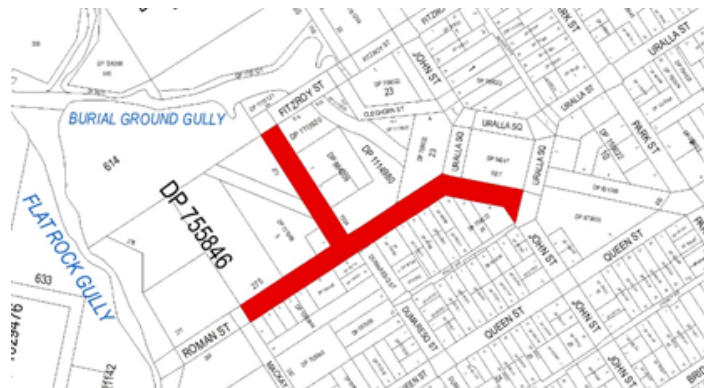

FLUORIDATION OF PUBLIC WATER SUPPLIES ACT 1957

Approval to Add Fluorine to a Public Water Supply (Oberon Council – Oberon Water Supply)

I, Dr Kerry Chant, **Chief Health Officer**, NSW Ministry of Health, duly appointed delegate of the Secretary of the NSW Ministry of Health, pursuant to section 6 of the *Fluoridation of Public Water Supplies Act 1957*, do approve Oberon Council, a water supply authority, to add fluorine to the water supply under its management and control supplied from the Oberon water treatment plant (in this direction referred to as the ‘Oberon water supply’).

This approval is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Oberon Council may only add fluorine to the Oberon water supply in accordance with any provisions, directions or approvals made under the *Fluoridation of Public Water Supplies Act 1957*, the *NSW Code of Practice for the Fluoridation of Public Water Supplies* made under that Act as amended from time to time, and the *Fluoridation of Public Water Supplies Regulation 2017* or any subsequent Regulation made in its place
2. Oberon Council shall maintain the content of fluorine in the Oberon water supply at a target concentration level of 1.0 mg/L (ppm) with an overall accuracy of +/- 5% and within an operating range of not more than 1.5 mg/L and not less than 0.9 mg/L and generally in accordance with the relevant provisions of the *NSW Code of Practice for the Fluoridation of Public Water Supplies*.
3. Oberon Council is prohibited from adding to the Oberon water supply fluorine in a form other than sodium fluoride or sodium silicofluoride.
4. Oberon Council shall comply with the Conditions of Operation of the Oberon water treatment plant fluoridation system, notified by Secretary of the NSW Ministry of Health in writing, as amended from time to time.

MAGISTRATES’ LEAVE AND RELATED PROVISIONS AMENDMENT
(TRANSITION TO RETIREMENT) DETERMINATION 2018

I, MARK SPEAKMAN, Attorney General, in pursuance of Clause 9 Schedule 1 of the *Local Court Act 2007*, do by this my Determination, amend the Magistrates’ Leave and Related Provisions Determination, as in force under Schedule 1 of the *Local Court Act 2007*.

1. *Revocation of previous determinations*

All previous determinations relating to part-time arrangements for magistrates are revoked.

2. *Definition of Part time Magistrate*

A part-time Magistrate is:

- (a) a Magistrate appointed permanently as a part-time Magistrate, as indicated in their commission (see cl. 3(a));
or
- (b) a Magistrate with a full time commission who has entered into an agreement with the Chief Magistrate that they will work part-time (see cl. 3(b)); or
- (c) a Magistrate with a full time commission who has entered into an agreement with the Chief Magistrate that they will work part-time as part of a transition to retirement (see cl. 7)

3. *General Conditions*

(a) Permanent Part-time Magistrates

All appointments of permanent part-time Magistrates must be specified as such in the commission of appointment. Part-time Magistrates are entitled to the same status, managerial commitment and support as full time Magistrates. Permanent part-time Magistrates shall work on days or periods as agreed in writing from time to time with the Chief Magistrate, but not less than 8 days in a four week period. The days or periods worked can be varied in writing with the consent of the Chief Magistrate and the Magistrate concerned.

(b) Temporary Part-time Magistrates

All agreements for Magistrates with a full time commission to work part time on a temporary basis must be approved by the Chief Magistrate. The days or periods on which the Magistrate shall work and a period, not exceeding 12 months, for which the Magistrate shall work part-time, shall be as agreed in writing between the Magistrate and the Chief Magistrate. The days or periods worked can be varied with consent of the Chief Magistrate and the Magistrate concerned. Such variations must be in writing. Temporary part time Magistrates must return to full time work at the expiration of the period agreed to in the agreement with the Chief Magistrate.

4. *Salary*

The salary of a part-time Magistrate shall be calculated on the salary, as determined from time to time by the Statutory and Other Officers Remuneration Tribunal, for the corresponding full-time position and will be paid on a pro-rata basis in accordance with the days agreed to be worked.

Payment for days worked outside the agreed days will also be paid on a pro-rata basis provided that the written approval of the Chief Magistrate to work those days has been obtained. Additional days worked are to be considered outside the terms of appointment for the purposes of the calculation of extended leave and superannuation.

5. *Leave and Related Conditions*

The Magistrates' Leave and Related Conditions Determination made pursuant to Schedule 1 of the *Local Court Act 2007* and set out in the New South Wales Magistrate's Handbook shall apply to part-time Magistrates subject to the following conditions.

(a) Extended Leave

For the purpose of determining the entitlement of a part-time Magistrate to extended leave, service shall be calculated on a pro-rata basis in accordance with the days agreed to be worked.

(b) Recreation Leave

Recreation leave for part-time Magistrates shall accrue on a pro-rata basis in accordance with the days agreed to be worked.

(c) Family and Community Leave

Family and Community leave for part-time Magistrates shall accrue on a pro-rata basis in accordance with the days agreed to be worked.

(d) Sick Leave

Part-time Magistrates shall have an entitlement to sick leave on a pro-rata basis in accordance with the days agreed to be worked.

(e) Public Holidays

Part-time Magistrates shall be entitled to public holidays which fall on the normal days agreed to be worked.

(f) Other Leave

Any other entitlements to leave shall be determined on a pro-rata basis in accordance with the days agreed to be worked.

6. *Telephone Allowances*

Part-time Magistrates are eligible for a partial reimbursement of telephone rental expenses. The entitlement of Magistrates to a reimbursement of 50% of telephone rental expenses shall be provided on a pro-rata basis to part-time Magistrates based on the number of days agreed to be worked

7. *Transition to retirement –arrangements*

- (a) Subject to the requirements of the Court, a Magistrate may enter into an arrangement as a transition to retirement if the arrangement is agreed to by the Chief Magistrate and a position is available.
- (b) If a Magistrate wished to enter into an arrangement (as a transition to retirement) the Magistrate must:
- (i) be at least 60 years old;
 - (ii) have completed their two years of country service;
 - (iii) undertake to forego the right to return to full-time employment as a Magistrate and have submitted a letter of resignation with a view to retirement nominating a date not greater than two years from the commencement of the transition to retirement arrangement;
 - (iv) agree to work alternate weeks or other such pattern of working hours determined by the Chief Magistrate; and
 - (v) agree to a limiting period that does not exceed two years after which point the Chief Magistrate will submit the letter of resignation or retirement to the Attorney General for consideration by the Governor of New South Wales.
- (c) Any arrangement under this clause must be by way of agreement in writing, signed by the Chief Magistrate and the Magistrate transitioning to retirement.
