### ROAD TRANSPORT ACT 2013

#### APPROVED SPEED MEASURING DEVICE ORDER 2019

I, the Honourable David Hurley AC DSC (Ret'd), Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the *Road Transport Act 2013* (the Act) do, by this my Order, approve the following type of device being designed for uses described hereunder:

A device approved for speed management, designed to measure the speed at which a vehicle is travelling (whether or not the vehicle concerned is also photographed), in accordance with the terms of section 134(1)(a) of the Act.

Type of device:

The speed measuring device, **SDS CAN Digital Speedometer**, manufactured by Ballinger Technology
