HERITAGE ACT 1977

INTERIM HERITAGE ORDER NO. 149

“Clooneen” 149 Livingstone Avenue, Pymble

- (i) make an interim heritage order in respect of the item of the environmental heritage specified or described in Schedule ‘A’; and
