- 2. Conservation works and activities:

All conservation works and activities clearly identified in the maintenance schedules or schedule of works for the site outlined in a future Conservation Management Plan endorsed by the Heritage Council of NSW.

3. Emergency management and response activities:

Any emergency management and response activities which may require immediate and urgent action.

4. Maintenance of existing non-significant infrastructure:

All maintenance of existing non-significant infrastructure including energy saving works, sustainable technologies (solar power, water tanks etc); electrical supply infrastructure; water and sewerage pipelines; pump stations and pits (including Sydney Water Sewerage Pumping Station SP0049 and Sydney Water Sewerage Pumping Station SP0114); fences; erosion control and soil conservation works; roads, fire and other trails and tracks including sub-grade, pavement and drainage works; workshop compound; where these works do not involve any impacts on fabric or spaces identified as being of exceptional, high or moderate significance in the 2013 Conservation Management Plan (or a future Conservation Management Plan endorsed by the Heritage Council of NSW) and do not involve ground disturbance below a depth of 100mm.

5. Upgrades to existing non-significant infrastructure:

Upgrades to existing non-significant infrastructure (such as Sydney Water Sewerage Pumping Station SP0049 and Sydney Water Sewerage Pumping Station SP0114) where such infrastructure is subterranean and where replacement services are contained within existing trenches and pits and do not involve any impacts fabric or spaces identified as being of exceptional, high or moderate significance in the 2013 Conservation Management Plan (or a future Conservation Management Plan endorsed by the Heritage Council of NSW).

6. Maintenance of existing non-significant visitor facilities:

All maintenance of existing non-significant visitor facilities including toilets, picnic shelters, signage, car parks, walking tracks, fencing, bollards, road barriers and road works which do not involve any impacts on

fabric or spaces identified as being of exceptional, high or moderate significance in the 2013 Conservation Management Plan (or a future Conservation Management Plan endorsed by the Heritage Council of NSW) and do not involve ground disturbance below a depth of 100mm.

# 7. Maintenance and repair of the sea wall:

All maintenance and repair of the sea wall using sympathetic materials and methods.

# 8. Maintenance, removal and replacement of swimming enclosure fabric:

All maintenance and like-for-like replacement of timber piles, cable and netting associated with the swimming enclosure and seasonal removal of the shark net.

# 9. Track maintenance:

Any track maintenance which does not involve ground disturbance below a depth of 100mm.

# 10. Bush regeneration activities:

All bush regeneration activities including re-vegetation which do not involve ground disturbance below a depth of 100mm.

# 11. Threatened species and communities recovery and pest management activities:

All threatened species and communities recovery and pest management activities which do not involve ground disturbance below a depth of 100mm.

# 12. Environmental rehabilitation work:

Environmental rehabilitation work including temporary silt fencing, tree planting, and weed removal and rubbish removal which does not involve ground disturbance below a depth of 100mm.

# 13. Treatment of non-culturally significant vegetation:

Manual, mechanical and chemical treatment of non-culturally significant vegetation which does not involve ground disturbance below a depth of 100mm.

# 14. Erection of new signage:

Erection of new signage associated with park use and management and/or interpretation in accordance with a Signage Strategy within a future Conservation Management Plan endorsed by the Heritage Council of NSW.

#### 15. Temporary infrastructure:

Temporary (not more than thirty days) infrastructure associated with events, functions and filming where the infrastructure does not involve any impacts on fabric or spaces identified as being of exceptional, high or moderate significance in the 2013 Conservation Management Plan (or a future Conservation Management Plan endorsed by the Heritage Council of NSW) and does not involve ground disturbance below a depth of 100mm.

# Declaration of significantly contaminated land

Section 11 of the Contaminated Land Management Act 1997

Declaration No. 20201110; Area No. 3463

The Environment Protection Authority (EPA) declares the following land to be significantly contaminated land under s 11 of the *Contaminated Land Management Act* 1997 (Act).

# Land to which this Declaration applies

- This Declaration applies to significantly contaminated land described as Lot 137 in DP 789376, within Newcastle Local Government Area, located at 2 Holland Street, Wickham NSW 2293 (Land).
- 2. A map of the Land is attached to this Declaration.

# Significant Contaminants affecting the Land

- 3. The EPA has reason to believe that the Land is contaminated with the following substances (Significant Contaminants) in such a way as to warrant regulation as significantly contaminated land under the Act:
  - (i) Total Recoverable Hydrocarbons (TRH);
  - (ii) Phase Separated Hydrocarbons (PSH);
  - (iii) Chlorinated Hydrocarbons; and
  - (iv) Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS).

#### Nature of harm caused, or that may be caused, by the Significant Contaminants

- 4. The EPA has reason to believe harm has been caused by the Significant Contaminants, including:
  - Soil and groundwater are contaminated with Significant Contaminants at concentrations exceeding guidelines that are protective of human health and the environment; and
  - (ii) Groundwater contaminated by PFAS has migrated from the Land beneath adjacent commercial and residential properties, limiting potential beneficial use of the groundwater and posing a potential risk to ecological receptors.
- 5. The EPA has reason to believe harm may be caused by the Significant Contaminants, including:
  - (i) There are potential risks to human receptors though vapour inhalation and dermal contact if contaminated soil or groundwater is disturbed or exposed; and
  - (ii) It is likely that Significant Contaminants, in addition to PFAS, could potentially migrate from the Land and cause further degradation of the groundwater.

# Matters considered before declaring the Land to be significantly contaminated land

- 6. Before making this Declaration, the EPA has taken into account relevant guidelines and each of the matters listed in s 12(1) of the Act with respect to the Significant Contaminants that the EPA believes cause the Land to be contaminated.
- 7. The EPA believes that the Land is contaminated, and that the contamination is significant enough to warrant regulation under the Act for the following reasons.
  - (i) Soil and groundwater are contaminated with TRH and chlorinated hydrocarbons at concentrations exceeding the guidelines that are protective of human health and the environment:
  - (ii) Groundwater contaminated by PFAS has migrated from the Land beneath adjacent commercial and residential properties, limiting potential beneficial use of the groundwater and posing a potential risk to ecological receptors;
  - (iii) PSH remaining beneath the central portion of the Land (up to 2m thickness) provides an ongoing secondary source of groundwater contamination, and active control is needed to prevent further degradation of the groundwater and potential migration of the contamination; and
  - (iv) There is a potential for human receptors, including commercial workers and intrusive maintenance workers, to be exposed to contaminants by vapour inhalation or dermal contact if soil or groundwater is disturbed or exposed.

# Further action to carry out voluntary management under the Act

8. The making of this Declaration does not prevent the carrying out of voluntary management of the Land by any person. Any person may submit a voluntary management proposal for the Land to the EPA.

## **Management Order may follow**

If management of the Land or part of the Land is required, the EPA may issue a Management Order under s 14 of the Act.

#### **Amendment or Repeal**

This declaration may be amended or repealed. It remains in force until it is otherwise amended or repealed. The subsequent declaration must state the reasons for the amendment or repeal (s 44 of the Act).

#### Information recorded by the EPA

Section 58 of the Act requires the EPA to maintain a public record. A copy of this significantly contaminated land declaration will be included in the public record and is available for access at the principal office of the EPA and on the EPA's website.

#### Information recorded by Councils

Section 59(a) of the Act requires the EPA to inform the relevant local Council as soon as practicable of this Declaration. Pursuant to s 59(2)(a) of the Act, land being declared to be significantly contaminated land is a prescribed matter to be specified in a planning certificate issued pursuant to s 10.7 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. The EPA is also required to inform the relevant Council as soon as practicable when the declaration is no longer in force. Pursuant to s 59(3) of the *Contaminated Land Management Act 1997*, if a Council includes advice in a planning certificate regarding a declaration of significantly contaminated land that is no longer in force, the Council is to make it clear on the planning certificate that the declaration no longer applies.

#### Relationship to other regulatory instruments

This Declaration does not affect the provisions of any relevant environmental planning instruments which apply to the land or provisions of any other environmental protection legislation administered by the EPA.

#### **MARINE SAFETY REGULATION 2016**

#### **EXEMPTION ORDER**

HIRE AND DRIVE PERSONAL WATERCRAFT - LICENCE EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED ON THE HAWKESBURY RIVER, NSW

Clause 140(1)

I, Alex Barrell, A/Executive Director, NSW Maritime, a delegate of Transport for NSW, pursuant to clause 140(1) of the *Marine Safety Regulation 2016* (the Regulation), hereby **EXEMPT** the operators of hire and drive personal watercraft used in conjunction with regulated tour activities conducted within the area of operations prescribed by Schedule 1 of this Order from the requirements of clause 103(1) of the Regulation - being the requirement to hold a personal watercraft driving licence - **SUBJECT TO** the conditions set out in Schedule 2 of this Order.

# **Object**

The object of this Exemption Order is to allow unlicensed persons to operate personal watercraft in the context of a supervised 'tour' operation in a safe and responsible way in waters specified in Schedule 1 of this Order, and while the operation is subject to a Certificate of Operation under the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel)* National Law Act 2012 of the Commonwealth for the hiring out of personal watercraft.

#### **Definition**

In this Notice, "regulated tour activities" means unlicensed personal watercraft hire and drive tour activities conducted by Richie's Events Pty Ltd T/A Jet Ski Safaris NSW in accordance with the Certificate of Operation COO-39922-001 issued by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority.

#### **SCHEDULE 1**

#### REGULATED TOUR ACTIVITIES - AREA OF OPERATIONS

This Exemption applies only to operators of personal watercraft participating in regulated tour activities conducted on the waters of the Hawkesbury River and connected tributaries bounded by a line drawn from the eastern extremity of Flat Rock Point in an easterly direction to the western extremity of Croppy Point and a line drawn from the east cardinal mark (CHR807) at the convergence of Mangrove Creek and the Hawkesbury River in a southern direction to Gentleman's Halt Wharf on the opposite shore of the Hawkesbury River.

# **SCHEDULE 2**

# **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- 1. This Order does not apply to:
  - a) Any person who is ineligible to hold a boat driving licence or is the subject of a boat driving licence suspension or disqualification under the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, or an equivalent disqualification in any other State or Territory; or
  - b) A person who is the subject of a written notice from Transport for NSW specifying that this Order does not apply to the person.
- 2. This Order applies only to the operator of a hire and drive personal watercraft who is:
  - a) operating a personal watercraft in accordance with the terms and conditions of a hire agreement with Richie's Events Pty Ltd T/A Jet Ski Safaris NSW; and
  - b) operating in accordance with specified waterway management matters as required by the tour operator ; and
  - c) wearing an appropriate lifejacket within the meaning of Part 6 of the Regulation; and
  - d) not operating the vessel at a speed exceeding 30 knots; and
  - e) a minimum of 16 years of age.
- 3. This Order ceases to apply in the event that the regulated tour activities are no longer subject to a Certificate of Operation issued by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority.

#### Note:

Failure to comply with a condition of this Order by a personal watercraft operator means that the Exemption ceases to apply to that person and if the person does not hold a personal watercraft driving licence, the vessel owner and operator may be liable for an offence under State and National laws.

# **Publication**

Pursuant to clause 140(3)(b) of the Regulation, this Order is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

This Notice takes effect on **30 August 2020** and will be in force for a period of 12 months from this date, unless revoked. This Order may be revoked at any time by Transport for NSW.

# 2 Commencement

This Order takes effect from the date of its publication in the NSW Government Gazette.

#### 3 Effect

This Order remains in effect until 31 December 2023 unless revoked earlier.

# 4 Interpretation

Words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as in road transport legislation, unless otherwise stated.

# 5 Definitions

In this Order:

**trial safety and traffic management plan** means the suite of documents developed in consultation between the approved person and Transport for NSW, which describe the safety and traffic management arrangements for the conduct of the trial, however identified, including a safety assurance plan, safety management plan and traffic management plan.

# Part 2 - Approval details 6

#### 6 Trial vehicles

The trial vehicles are AEV Robotics electric vehicles with Chassis Numbers AEV03 and AEV04.

# 7 Approved person

The University of Sydney – ABN: 51 211 513 464 is the approved person to use the trial vehicles.

# 8 Responsibility for vehicle

- 8.1 A vehicle supervisor must be in a trial vehicle at all times when the vehicle is in use and must hold as a minimum a current Australian driver licence Class C.
- 8.2 The *driver* of the vehicle is:
  - (a) the vehicle supervisor when the vehicle is not in automated mode; or (b) if the vehicle is in automated mode, the approved person.
- 8.3 The *person in charge* of the vehicle in all modes of operation is both:
  - (a) the vehicle supervisor; and
  - (b) the approved person.

# 9 Road Transport Legislation exemption

9.1 A vehicle supervisor is exempt from rule 299 (1) of the Road Rules 2014.

Note: Clause 9 of the Order has effect pursuant to Road Transport Act 2013 section 19 – Power of Minister to exclude vehicles, persons or animals. The clause exempts the driver from the requirement of driving with a Visual Display Unit (VDU) operating and visible.

# Part 3 – Operating conditions

Note: The Minister may under Part 5.6 of the *Road Transport Act 2013* impose conditions on a trial approval and the manner and circumstances in which the trial is to be conducted (in addition to the statutory conditions imposed by that Act).

The following conditions apply to the trial approval:

# 10 Vehicle standards and performance

- 10.1 The vehicles must be suitable for safe use and in a thoroughly serviceable condition.
- 10.2 The trial vehicles are to be registered subject to the following conditions:
  - (a) L03 Trial vehicle may be operated only within the trial area as stated in clause 11.1 of this Order;
  - (b) SP50 Restricted to a maximum speed of 50km/h in manual operation; and the Authority is directed to register the trial vehicles accordingly.

#### 11 Trial area

- 11.1 A trial vehicle must only be operated or used on road or road related areas within the State of New South Wales (the **trial area**).
- 11.2 The trial is to be conducted in stages within the trial area as approved by Transport for NSW and only when Transport for NSW is satisfied the trial vehicle has been assessed as capable of operating in accordance with a trial safety and traffic management plan as applicable for each stage.
- 11.3 The approved person must not operate a trial vehicle until it has received written notice from Transport for NSW that operations can begin in any specific stage.
- 11.4 A trial vehicle may operate on roads within the trial area for the purpose of mapping, testing and verifying of data for the purpose of future trial stages but only in accordance with a trial safety and traffic management plan approved by Transport for NSW for that purpose.

# 12 Persons travelling in a trial vehicle

- 12.1 Passengers less than 18 years of age are not permitted to ride in a trial vehicle;
- 12.2 No more than two persons (including the vehicle supervisor) are allowed to ride in a trial vehicle.

Note: Part 15 of the NSW Road Rules 2014 applying to passengers on or in vehicles continue to apply.

# 13 Promotional and display activities

For the purpose of any promotion or display, a trial vehicle may:

- (a) stand on any road or road related area in accordance with any applicable prescribed traffic control devices; and
- (b) be operated within the trial area to load or unload a trial vehicle from another vehicle.

Note: clause 13 of the Order has effect pursuant to Road Transport Act 2013 section 19 – Power of Minister to exclude vehicles, persons or animals.

# 14 Trial Safety and traffic management plans

- 14.1 A trial vehicle must be used and operated in accordance with the trial safety and traffic management plan.
- 14.2 The trial safety and traffic management plan must include a general risk analysis (identifying, assessing hazards and controlling risks) including the matters listed in paragraph 5.2 of the *Guidelines for trials of automated vehicles in Australia* published by Austroads and the National Transport Commission in 2017.

# 15 Operating reports

15.1 **Notification obligations** – the approved person must notify and submit a report to Transport for NSW for each incident of the following types of incidents within the stated time period from the relevant incident:

Incident type	Verbal notification	Written notification
Injury – a fatality or injury to any person including any incident which must be reported to SafeWork New South Wales and NSW Police Force (as in accordance with relevant NSW laws).	10 minutes	6 hours
<b>Collision</b> – any uncontrolled or unplanned contact between the trial vehicle and another road user or object.	10 minutes	6 hours
Any other <b>notifiable incident</b> under the Work Health and Safety Act 2011.	10 minutes	24 hours
Vehicle supervisor <i>intervention</i> to exert any control over the trial vehicle when it is operating in automated mode.	24 hours	24 hours
Road Rules contraventions – contraventions of NSW Road Rules 2014 by the vehicle supervisor and/or approved person when operating the trial vehicle, whether or not an offence is committed.	6 hours	24 hours
Near-misses involving the trial vehicle with any other vehicle or road user or animal.	6 hours	24 hrs
<b>Security breach</b> – any event involving unplanned or unauthorised access to or control of the trial vehicle by any person other than the vehicle supervisor or approved person.	6 hours	24 hours
Any verbal or written complaints about the performance or operation of the vehicle to the vehicle supervisor or approved person.	24 hours	24 hrs

- 15.2 **Notification details** the approved person must include the following information in each incident notification:
  - (a) time;
  - (b) date;
  - (c) location;
  - (d) automation status (for example, automated system, vehicle supervisor, transitioning, etc);
  - (e) driver and person in charge of the vehicle at the time of the incident;
  - (f) number of passengers, seating position and use of restraints by each passenger and age of each passenger;

- (g) traffic conditions (for example, empty road, in heavy traffic, etc);
- (h) road and weather conditions;
- vehicle information (for example vehicle speed, brake/throttle applications, vehicle fault condition description, etc);
- (j) sensor information in relation to other road users and the surrounding road environment;
- (k) description of reported incident and
- (I) classification of the incident type as determined in consultation with TfNSW.

# 16 Security breach reporting to NSW Police Force

16.1 Any event involving unplanned or unauthorised access to or control of a trial vehicle (including by electronic means), other than the vehicle supervisor or approved person must be immediately reported to NSW Police Force upon detection of the breach.

# 17 Research and assurance reporting

The approved person must provide reports to TfNSW as agreed with TfNSW.


