LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993

ORDER

The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal, delegate of the Minister for Local Government, pursuant to the delegation dated 6 September 2010, by this Order:

- (a) under section 506 of the *Local Government Act* 1993 (NSW), specifies that the maximum percentage by which councils' general income (as defined under section 505(a) of the *Local Government Act* 1993 (NSW)), for the year 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022 may increase is 2.0%.
- (b) under section 508 (7) of the *Local Government Act* 1993 (NSW), specifies that no limitation is to apply to the annual charges made by councils under section 507 of the *Local Government Act* 1993 (NSW) for domestic waste management services for the year 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022.
