GEOGRAPHICAL NAMES ACT 1966

PURSUANT to the provisions of Section 8 of the *Geographical Names Act 1966*, the Geographical Names Board hereby notifies that it proposes to assign the following names in the Georges River LGA:

Annie Twiss Reserve for a reserve located between Gloucester Road and Illawarra Parade, Beverly Hills.

Gloucester Reserve for a reserve located on Gloucester Road, north of the intersection with Stoney Creek Road, Beverly Hills.

Jock Marshall Reserve for a reserve located between Gloucester Road and Cahill Street, Beverly Hills.

Rainbow Lorikeet Reserve for a reserve located on the corner of Stoney Creek Road and Gloucester Road, Hurstville.

The position and extent for these features is recorded and shown within the Geographical Names Register of New South Wales. The proposals can be viewed and submissions lodged on the Geographical Names Board website at <u>www.gnb.nsw.gov.au</u> from 21 April to 21 May 2021. Alternatively, written submissions may be mailed to the Secretary, Geographical Names Board, 346 Panorama Ave, Bathurst, NSW 2795.

In accordance with Section 9 of the *Geographical Names Act 1966,* all submissions lodged may be subject to a Government Information (Public Access) application and may be viewed by a third party to assist the Board in considering this proposal.

Anti-Discrimination Act 1977

EXEMPTION ORDER

Under the provisions of section 126 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act* 1977 (NSW), an exemption is given from sections 25, 33 and 51 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act* 1977 (NSW) to The Australia Institute Ltd to advertise and recruit up to 4 women aged 18-27 per year for a graduate style fellowship program.

This exemption will remain in force for 6 years.
