Upon closing, title to the land, comprising the former public road, will vest in Bega Valley Shire Council as operational land for the purposes of the *Local Government Act 1993*.

MARINE NOTICE

Section 12

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Hastings River – 100 metres upstream and downstream Rawdon Island Bridge, Rawdon Island.

Duration

9 July 2021 until further notice

Detail

Vessel operators are advised that the waterway at the location has been closed to boating. The restriction is due to the severe structural damage in the pile foundations above seabed level at a number of points on the Bridge, creating a danger to navigation.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the closure and will be marked by the presence of yellow aqua buoys, and the restriction will also be indicated on signage and on buoys at the location pursuant to section 11 of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

Penalties may apply (Section 12 (5) - Marine Safety Act 1998).
