# Rail Safety (Adoption of National Law) Act 2012

Exemption from requirement to undertake periodic health assessments

**TAKE notice** that, pursuant to section 203 of the Rail Safety National Law (NSW) as adopted by the Rail Safety (Adoption of National Law) Act 2012 (NSW) I the Hon Andrew Constance MP, Minister for Transport and Roads (the Responsible Minister) in New South Wales, do hereby:

Exempt the rail transport operators prescribed below from the requirement to comply with section 114 of the Rail Safety National Law (as it applies in this jurisdiction) and Regulation 27 of the Rail Safety National Law National Regulations (as it applies in this jurisdiction).

Take further notice that this exemption is subject to the following conditions:

- (1) This exemption only applies to periodic health assessments only. It does not include triggered health assessments, pre-placement or change of risk category health assessments.
- (2) Rail transport operators must comply with the provisions of section 114 so far as is reasonably practicable to do so. The exemption only applies where the rail transport operator has:
  - a. Identified that there are issues accessing authorised health professions as a result of impacts from the global pandemic COVID-19 (as declared by the World Health Organisation in March 2020), and completed a risk assessment for the affected rail safety workers which determines, based on their most recent health assessment, that it is low risk to postpone the periodic health assessment and allow workers to continue undertaking rail safety work until such time as the assessment can be scheduled:
  - b. fully documented any change management and consultation processes in relation to operating under this exemption, and communicated this within its organisation;
- (3) Rail transport operators cannot transfer or assign the exemption conferred by this Notice.

# ROAD TRANSPORT ACT 2013 EXEMPTION ORDER SECTION 19

# Ministerial (Change of Residential Address) Exemption Order 2021

I, Andrew Constance, Minister for Transport and Roads, pursuant to section 19(1) of the *Road Transport Act 2013*, make this Order.

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#### 1. Citation

This Order is the Ministerial (Change of Residential Address) Exemption Order 2021.

#### 2. Commencement

This Order has effect on and from 6 August 2021

#### 3. Effect

This Order remains in force up to and including 6 November 2021 unless revoked earlier.

## 4. Interpretation

Words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as in the *Road Transport Act 2013* unless otherwise stated.

"DL Regulation" means the Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2017

"VR Regulation" means the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2017

#### 5. Application

This Order applies to the holder of a NSW driver licence and/or the registered operator of a NSW registered vehicle.

# 6. Declaration

Notwithstanding the requirements in clauses

- 122(1)(b) of the DL Regulation; and
- 37(1)(b) of the VR Regulation;

a person to whom this Order applies is not required to notify Transport for NSW of a change of residential or home address (however described) within 14 days of changing such address and the 14 day period required by the Regulations commences only upon the expiration of this Order.

#### 7. Publication

This Order is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

# **Explanatory notes:**

Clauses 122(1)(b) of the DL Regulation and 37(1)(b) of the VR Regulation both require a person who changes their 'residential address' or 'home address' (respectively) to notify Transport for NSW within 14 days of the change.

As a result of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, administrative issues have arisen which require certain customers to present in person to a Service Centre in order to notify and verify any such change of address. However personal attendance at Service Centres may be challenging as a result of Public Health Orders in place at the time of making of this Order, and personal attendance is not recommended in some Local Government Areas that are subject to stay-at-home orders.

The purpose of this Order is to provide any person who changes address during the period of the Order with ample time to inform Transport for NSW of the change, without being liable for an offence against the respective regulations.
