#### Detail

Water ski shows and fireworks events will be conducted at the location at the above mentioned dates and times.

The events will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow lines and the possibility of persons in the water from time to time, presenting a potential hazard to other waterway users.

Fireworks displays staged from land over the waterway will take place at the conclusion of events on the following listed dates: Saturday 8 January 2022, Saturday 15 January 2022, Saturday 22 January 2022, Saturday 29 January 2022 and Saturday 12 March 2022.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the events and will comprise the waters of Lake Mulwala within the 4 knot zone of the Mulwala Ski Club lagoon.

The exclusion zone will be indicated by the presence of control vessels, temporary buoyage (event dependent) and signage located at the Mulwala Ski Club boat ramp and foreshore.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

#### **REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE**

#### Location

Jervis Bay – near the township of Huskisson and the landmark of Shark Net Beach, between the southern side of Currambene Creek entrance and Tapalla Point then extending 500 metres into Jervis Bay to the unnamed island.

#### Duration

6:00am to 12:30pm – Saturday 6 November 2021 6:00am to 10:30am – Sunday 7 November 2021

#### Detail

The swimming legs of various triathlon races will be conducted on the waters of Jervis Bay at the location specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will be indicated by the presence of course rounding buoys, although the Exclusion Zone itself will extend for 50 meters outside the rounding buoys. The Exclusion Zone will be patrolled by Maritime, Police and event control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

#### Location

Talbingo Reservoir, Talbingo

#### Duration

- 7:00am to 5:00pm Saturday 30 October 2021

#### Detail

Trials involving the use of a high speed vessel powered by a jet engine will be conducted on the waters of Talbingo Reservoir during the dates and times specified above. The jet powered vessel will be operating at very high speed and will present a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will extend south from the Dam Wall, approximately 9km to Point Monster, including Honeysuckle and Waterfall Bays. All vessels and persons, other than those involved in the trials, must not enter the area.

The Southern end of the zone will be monitored by control vessels adjacent to Point Monster.
