Proclamation

under the

National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974

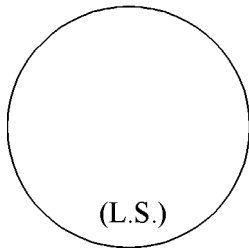
MARGARET BEAZLEY, Governor

I, the Honourable Margaret Beazley AC QC, Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and under the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*, section 71O(2), do, by this my Proclamation—

- (a) revoke the existing reservation of the lands reserved as Mount Yarrowyck Nature Reserve, and
- (b) vest the lands in the Anaiwan Local Aboriginal Land Council and the Armidale Local Aboriginal Land Council, and
- (c) reserve the lands as Bulagaranda (Mt Yarrowyck) Aboriginal Area.
