REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

**Location**

Hastings River, Port Macquarie – approximately 100m south east of the southern end of Pelican Island, Port Macquarie

**Duration**

- 9:00pm to 9:15pm – Saturday 17 April 2021

**Detail**

Fireworks displays will be conducted over the navigable waters of Port Macquarie at the location specified above. Fireworks will be launched from a moored firing barge at the above location. The area directly around this firing position may be dangerous and hazardous to other waterway users while fireworks are being launched.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the events, extending 150 metres around the firing barge moored near the inter-tidal flats to the south east of Pelican Island. This zone will be indicated by the presence of control vessels which will be stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

Little Bay, Botany Bay

**Duration**

- 6:00am to 8:00pm – Tuesday 2 March 2021
- 6:00am to 8:00pm – Wednesday 3 March 2021
- 6:00am to 8:00pm – Thursday 4 March 2021

**Detail**

Vessel operators are advised that an event will be held on the navigable waters of Little Bay during the above dates and times and at the location specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event on the waters of Little Bay, Botany Bay approximately 500 metres from the shoreline from Tupia Head, south approximately 2.3 kilometres to the northern end of Cape Banks.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be patrolled by Maritime and Police vessels stationed around the boundary.

**Location**

Sydney Harbour – Farm Cove

**Duration**

Tuesday 2 March 2021 to Saturday 8 May 2021

**Detail**

The Handa Opera event will take place in Farm Cove on the dates specified above, and comprises a construction, performance and deconstruction period.

**Exclusion Zones**

A **Construction/Deconstruction Exclusion Zone** will be established on the eastern side of Farm Cove and will extend approximately 200m from construction works related to the establishment of the event stage.

The Construction/Deconstruction Exclusion Zone will be in force:

- 24 hours per day – between 12:01am Tuesday 2 March to 11:59pm Tuesday 23 March 2021, and
- 24 hours per day – between 12:01am Monday 26 April to 11:59pm Saturday 8 May 2021

A **Performance Exclusion Zone** will be established to maintain safety during event performances and will encompass all waters of Farm Cove south of a line marked by lit yellow buoys extending west from Mrs Macquaries Point.

The Performance Exclusion Zone will be in force:

- From 6:30pm to 10:30pm every day between Wednesday 24 March to Sunday 25 April 2021

The Exclusion Zones will be marked by lit yellow buoys and patrolled by control and security vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

The exclusion zones are illustrated on the attached map.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

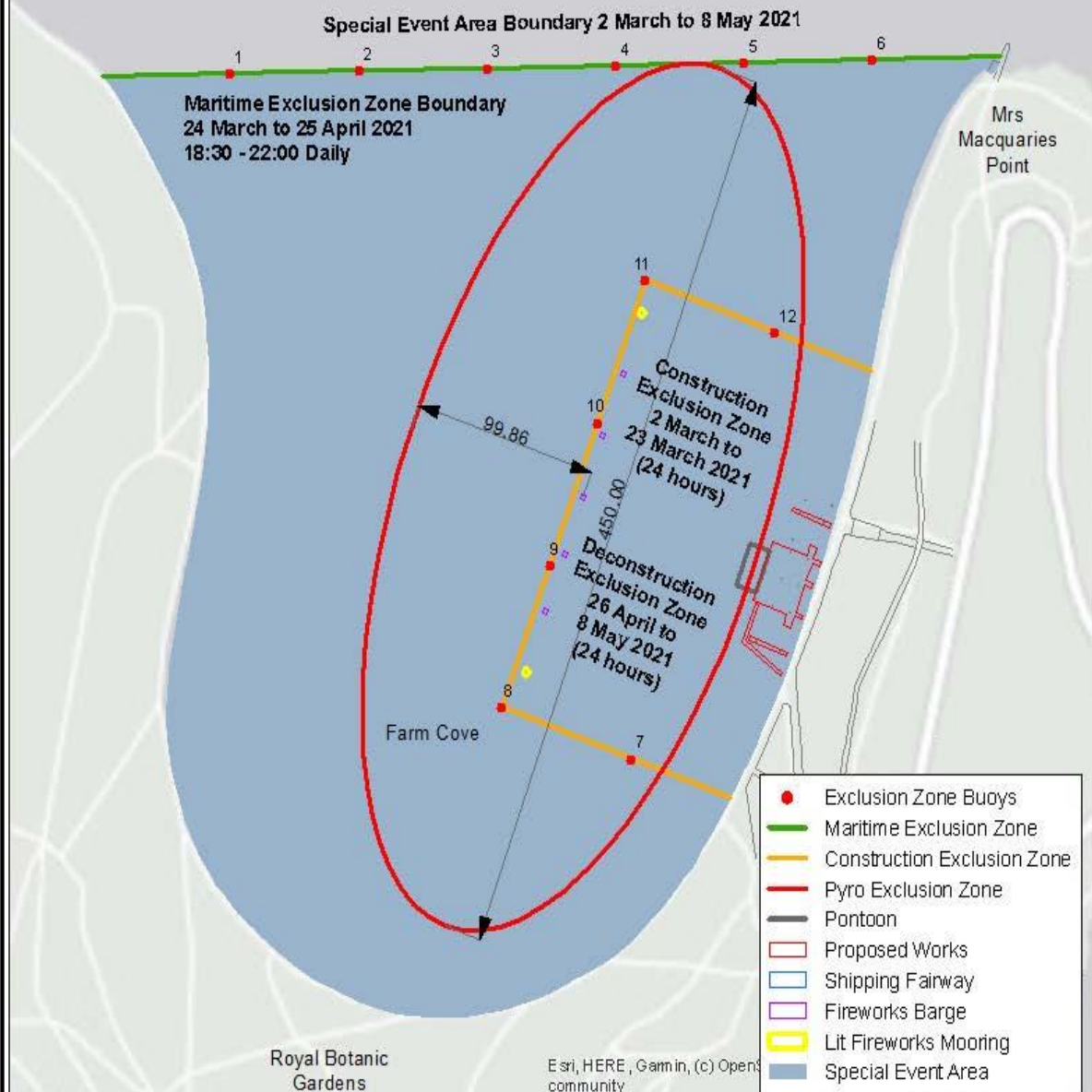

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

**Location**

Lake Illawarra – extending from the shoreline of Burroo Point near the land-based locality of Ski Way Park at Oak Flats.

**Duration**

- 7:00am to 4:00pm – Saturday 6 March 2021.

**Detail**

Dragon boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Illawarra at the location specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, comprising of a square shape (approximately 250 metres by 250 metres), which will be indicated by the presence of buoys and control vessels stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

Tasman Sea adjoining Wollongong Harbour and waters within Wollongong Harbour defined by:

1. the shoreline of Wollongong Harbour adjacent to the intersection of Harbour Street and Cliff Road, to
2. the eastern side of the remnants of the stone structure adjacent to the former Wollongong Slipway, to
3. the entrance into Wollongong Harbour from the Tasman Sea, to
4. the shoreline of the Tasman Sea at the North Wollongong Beach, and directly in front of the Surf Lifesaving Club and Pavilion.

The swimming leg of a triathlon will be conducted at the location specified above.

## **Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017**

### **Notice under clause 43 Booking service for wheelchair accessible taxis**

#### **Approval of wheelchair accessible taxi booking service**

Notice is hereby given, under clause 43 of the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017, that the booking service specified in Schedule 1 is approved as a wheelchair accessible taxi booking service in relation to the members of the class of taxi service providers described.

#### **Revocation of previous approval of wheelchair accessible taxi booking service**

The approval of Zero Two Hundred service operated by Taxis Combined Services Pty Ltd (ABN: 11 001 235 847) as a wheelchair accessible taxi booking service notified in NSW Government Gazette No 126 of 24 November 2017 at page 7316, is revoked.

This notice takes effect at the beginning of 1 March 2021.

#### **Schedule 1**

Booking service—Spinal Cord Injuries Australia (ABN 93 001 263 734)

Class of taxi service providers—taxi service providers who provide services using wheelchair accessible taxis in the Metropolitan Transport District

Note: Under clause 43 of the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017 a taxi service provider who provides services using wheelchair accessible taxis must enter into an arrangement for the provision of booking services for the wheelchair accessible taxis with a booking service approved as a wheelchair accessible taxi booking service by the Commissioner.
