Location

Bennetts Beach, Hawks Nest – adjacent to the Hawks Nest Surf Life Saving Club

Duration

• 9.00am to 12.30pm – Saturday 19 March 2022

Detail

A number of swim events will be conducted on the navigable waters of Bennetts Beach, Hawks Nest specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels stationed around the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

Section 12(2)

REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Wallis Lake, Forster - Pipers Creek from Cavill Avenue to Kenrose Canal

Duration

8.00am to 5.00pm on the following dates:

• Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 March 2022

Detail

Dragon Boat Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Wallis Lake, Forster specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be marked by the presence of control vessels stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for control vessels to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the course via a 'transit lane'.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act* 1998, all vessels using the transit lane:

- Must not exceed the maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)
