PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT OPERATIONS (WASTE) REGULATION 2014

Notice under Clause 21A: Notice of variation of other requirements for levy exempt mixed waste organic outputs

I, James Goodwin, Acting Executive Director Regulatory Operations of the Environment Protection Authority (EPA), sub-delegate of the EPA:

- (a) vary the following notice under clause 21A of the *Protection of the Environment Operations* (*Waste*) *Regulation 2014*:
 - (i) the notice on published in Government Gazette No 182 of 2 May 2021 (**Notice**);
- (b) specify the following variations to the other requirements for mixed waste organic outputs for the purposes of clause 21A, pursuant to clause 21A(3)(b), by inserting Notice clause 3:
 - 3. Has in the alternative to the requirements specified in clauses 1 and 2 of this notice, been processed as required by Prevention Notice 3501924, as varied by Variation of Prevention Notice 3502134 issued pursuant to Chapter 4 of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997*.

This notice commences on the date it is published in the NSW Government Gazette.
