ORDER

Maximum tariff for purposes of the definition of boarding house and lodging house

Under delegation from the Minister administering the *Local Government Act 1993*, I determine that for the period 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023 (inclusive) the maximum tariff, exclusive of GST, for a boarding house or lodging house for the purposes of section 516(1A) of that Act is:

(a) Where full board and lodging is provided-

\$409 per week for single accommodation; or

\$675 per week for family or shared accommodation.

(b) Where less than full board and lodging is provided-

\$275 per week for single accommodation; or

\$454 per week for family or shared accommodation.
