DISAPPEARANCE

TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000) REWARD

On the 22 June 1997, Marion Barter (also known as Florabella Natalia Marion Remakel), aged 51 years, was last seen at a bus depot in Southport, Queensland. She has not been seen since and fears are held for her safety.

Notice is hereby given that a reward of up to two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) will be paid by the Government of New South Wales for information that leads to the discovery of Marion BARTER's whereabouts or discloses the circumstances of her disappearance.

BUILDING AND DEVELOPMENT CERTIFIERS REGULATION 2020

NOTICE

- 1. Under clause 65 of the Building and Development Certifiers Regulation 2020 (the Regulation) the Commissioner for NSW Fair Trading, Department of Customer Service, is satisfied that there is no person reasonably available who holds an accreditation to perform the following regulated work under the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021 (EPA Regulation) and the Environmental Planning and Assessment (Development Certification and Fire Safety) Regulation 2021 (EPA (DCFS) Regulation):
 - the preparation of a performance solution report in respect to a fire safety requirement under section 137 of the EPA Regulation and section 18 of the EPA (DCFS) Regulation;
 - b. the endorsement of plans and specifications for a relevant fire safety system, being a ducted smoke control system <u>only</u>, under section 147 of the EPA Regulation and section 22 of the EPA (DCFS) Regulation; and
 - c. the endorsement of a non-compliance with specified provisions of the Building Code of Australia (**BCA**) relating to the operational performance of a relevant fire safety system under section 74 of the EPA (DCFS) Regulation.

Under clause 65(3)(b)(ii) of the Regulation the Commissioner for NSW Fair Trading, Department of Customer Service, authorises the following class of registered certifiers and principal certifiers to appoint an appropriate person to carry out the regulated work of that kind if the relevant registered certifier or principal certifier certifies in writing that in the reasonable opinion of the certifier the person is competent to carry out the regulated work:

- a. a registered certifier authorised to issue a complying development certificate for building work that requires a performance solution report under section 137 of the EPA Regulation;
- b. a registered certifier that is authorised to issue a construction certificate for building work that requires a performance solution report under section 18 of the EPA (DCFS) Regulation:
- c. a registered certifier authorised to issue a complying development certificate for building work or the appointed principal certifier for building work that is subject to a condition required by section 147 of the EPA Regulation, in relation to plans and specifications of a relevant fire safety system, being a ducted smoke control system only;
- d. a registered certifier authorised to issue a construction certificate for building work or the appointed principal certifier for building work that is subject to a condition required by section 22 of the EPA (DCFS) Regulation, in relation to plans and specifications of a relevant fire safety system, being a ducted smoke control system <u>only</u>;

- e. a registered certifier authorised to issue a complying development certificate for building work for which an objection has been lodged with the certifier under section 74 of the EPA (DCFS) Regulation; and
- f. a registered certifier authorised to issue a construction certificate for building work for which an objection has been lodged with the certifier under section 74 of the EPA (DCFS) Regulation.

BUILDING AND DEVELOPMENT CERTIFIERS REGULATION 2020

NOTICE

- 1. Under clause 65 of the Building and Development Certifiers Regulation 2020 (the Regulation) the Commissioner for NSW Fair Trading, Department of Customer Service, is satisfied that there is no person reasonably available who holds an accreditation to perform the following regulated work under the Environmental Planning and Assessment (Development Certification and Fire Safety) Regulation 2021 (EPA (DCFS) Regulation):
 - a. the assessment of essential fire safety measures and critical fire safety measures for the purposes of an annual fire safety statement or supplementary fire safety statement that are not:
 - statutory fire safety measures as listed in section 79(4) of the EPA (DCFS) Regulation;
 - ii. a non-statutory fire safety measure:
 - A relating to emergency planning; or
 - B relating to fire alarm system monitoring;
 - iii. performance solutions for statutory fire safety measures listed in section 79(4) of the EPA (DCFS) Regulation and the non-statutory fire safety measures under item 1.a. ii.

Under clause 65(3)(b)(ii) of the Regulation the Commissioner for NSW Fair Trading, Department of Customer Service, authorises owners of buildings that contain essential fire safety measures or critical fire safety measures described in 1(a) above to appoint an appropriate person to carry out such regulated work if the relevant building owner certifies in writing that in the reasonable opinion of the owner the person is competent to carry out the regulated work.
