REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Lower Coolongolook River/ Cape Hawke Harbour/ Wallis Lake, Forster NSW - Forster/ Tuncurry Bridge/ Miles Island/ Little Tern Island

Duration

• 8.30pm to 9.30pm - Friday 31 December 2021

Detail

A fireworks display will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lower Coolongolook River/ Cape Hawke Harbour/ Wallis Lake, Forster NSW specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, 250 metres around the fireworks deployment barge and will be patrolled by Maritime and Police vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

SPECIAL RESTRICTION

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Marine Safety Act 1998, vessels navigating in the vicinity of the Forster/Tuncurry Bridge

- must not exceed a speed of 4 knots and
- must produce no wash.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Murray River and Darling River – the entire width of the river between the townships of Mildura (Victoria) and Wentworth (NSW) at the following locations:

- 7.00am to 2.00pm Saturday 22 January 2022 Murray River between the 884km river marker (downstream of the Mildura Lock) downstream to the Wentworth Weir, and junction of the Murray and Darling Rivers, and upstream on the Darling River to the 4km river marker
- 2.00pm to 6.00pm Saturday 22 January 2022 on the Murray River between the 856km river marker (1km upstream of the Coomealla boat ramp) downstream to the Wentworth Weir, and junction of the Murray and Darling Rivers, and upstream on the Darling River to the 4km river marker
- 7.00am to 6.00pm Sunday 23 January 2022 the Murray River between the 884km river marker (downstream of the Mildura Lock) downstream to the Wentworth Weir, and junction of the Murray and Darling Rivers, and upstream on the Darling River to the 4km river marker.

Duration

7.00am to 6.00pm on the following dates:

Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 January 2022

Detail

Competitive ski racing will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Murray River as specified above.

The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels, persons being towed at speed using towlines and persons in the water from time to time – presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the full width of the Murray River between the locations detailed on the respective days above. The area will be marked by buoys and patrolled by control vessels. Unauthorised vessels and persons are prohibited from entering the exclusion zone during the times specified above.

REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Manning River, Taree - between Martin Bridge and Dumaresq Island

Duration

- 9.00am to 5.00pm Saturday 22 January 2022
- 9.00am to 1.00pm Sunday 23 January 2022

Detail

A number of jet powered vessel trials will be conducted on the waters of the Manning River, as specified above. The event will involve the use of powered vessels operating at speed - presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event at the above location which will be indicated by the presence of control vessels.

All vessel operators and persons using the waters in the vicinity of the event should keep a proper lookout, keep well clear of the jet powered vessel and support vessels, and exercise extreme caution.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be monitored and patrolled by control vessels.

Provision has been made for vessels to transit the Zone during breaks in the trials. Control vessels may, at times during the trials, authorise vessel traffic to pass through the Zone.

REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Tasman Sea adjoining Wollongong Harbour and waters within Wollongong Harbour defined by:

- the shoreline of Wollongong Harbour adjacent to the intersection of Harbour Street and Cliff Road, to
- 2. the eastern side of the remnants of the stone structure adjacent to the Wollongong Slipway, to
- 3. the entrance into the Wollongong Harbour from the Tasman Sea, to
- 4. a point extending approximately 30 metres past the Northern break wall into the Tasman Sea.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone, which will be patrolled by Maritime and Police vessels stationed around the boundary.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be monitored by control vessels stationed on the perimeter.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone, which will be patrolled by Transport for NSW and NSW Police vessels.
