# REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE & SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

# Location

Hunter River, Raymond Terrace – entire width of the river downstream from the Fitzgerald Bridge, between the prolongations of Bourke Street and Swan Street

# **Duration**

9.00am to 5.00pm on the following dates:

- Sunday 8 May 2022
- Saturday 4 June 2022
- Sunday 5 June 2022
- Saturday 13 August 2022
- Sunday 14 August 2022

## **Detail**

A number of high-speed powerboat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Hunter River, Raymond Terrace at the dates and times specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be indicated by control vessels stationed on and patrolling the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

# **Transit lane**

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the course via a 'transit lane'.

# **Special Restrictions**

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Marine Safety Act 1998, all vessels using the transit lane:

- Must not exceed the maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

# **REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE**

# Location

Wagonga Inlet, Narooma – within a 200 metre radius from a barge positioned approximately 300 metres west of the landmark of Quota Park and midway between Shell Point and Lavender Point

# **Duration**

8.00pm to 10.00pm – Friday 6 May 2022

### **Detail**

A fireworks display will be conducted over the navigable waters of Wagonga Inlet, Narooma specified above, and will involve the use of a stationary barge as a launch platform. The area directly around the barge may be dangerous and hazardous while fireworks are being launched.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be monitored and maintained by event staff and control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

Manning River, adjacent to Queen Elizabeth Park, Taree between Endeavour Place boat ramp & the Martin Bridge

# **Duration**

8.00am to 4.00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 30 April 2022
- Sunday 1 May 2022

# Detail

Rowing Regattas will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Manning River, as specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified at the above location while the events are in progress. The Zone will consist of a 1 kilometre course and will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

# **Transit Lane**

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a 'transit lane'.

# **Special Restrictions**

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Act, vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

### REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

# Location

Lake Mulwala – near the locality of the Mulwala Water Ski Club and within an area bounded by:

- The Mulwala foreshore between the land-based localities of the Yarrawonga Yacht Club and west to the Melbourne Street Bridge, then
- North to a location directly east of the Lake Edge Resort.
- East into Lake Mulwala for a distance of approximately 750 metres, then
- South towards Yarrawonga Yacht Club.

# **Duration**

- 8.00am to 6.00pm Friday 22 April 2022
- 8.00am to 6.00pm Saturday 23 April 2022
- 8.00am to 6.00pm Sunday 24 April 2022

## Detail

Competitive powerboat racing will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Mulwala as specified above. The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users. Support vessels will be present to manage the event.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event. Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone, which will marked by buoys and monitored and maintained by control and patrol vessels.

# **Transit Lane**

A 'transit lane' will be established along the foreshore from the Lake Mulwala Holiday Park, south of the Mulwala Water Ski Club, to the Melbourne Street bridge, Mulwala, within which a control vessel may, at times during the event, authorise local vessel traffic to pass through.

Pursuant to s 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, **SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS** are applicable to vessels using the transit lane:

- Maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce no wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

# **REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE**

# Location

Wollongong Harbour – all navigable waters bounded and marked by buoys between:

- The shoreline adjacent to the intersection of Harbour Street and Cliff Road (adjacent to Le Vendi café), to
- the centre of the entrance to the Wollongong Harbour, to
- the eastern side of the remnants of the stone structure adjacent to the Wollongong Slipway.

## **Duration**

6.00am to 2.00pm - Sunday 24 April 2022

### **Detail**

The swimming leg of a triathlon will be conducted on the waters of Wollongong Harbour at the location specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event. The exclusion zone will follow the shape created by the course rounding buoys, as specified above, and will extend for 20 metres outside the buoys at the above times.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be patrolled by official vessels.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998).
