ORDER

Withdrawal of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* an Order has been made on **Miss Lynette Jenene ROBB** (**PAR0002264948**), of WOODBURN NSW 2472, prohibiting her, as an ambulance officer employed by NSW Ambulance from having possession of or supplying a drug of addiction as authorised by clause 101(1) of the Regulation.

This Order is to take effect on and from 21 January 2022.

ORDER

Withdrawal of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation* 2008 an Order has been made on **Dr Phong Ky Ho (MED0001854313)** of Five Dock NSW 2046, prohibiting him until further notice, as a medical practitioner, from supplying or having possession of drugs of addiction as authorised by clause 101 of the Regulation and issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clause 77 of the Regulation.
