Competitive power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Hawkesbury River at the dates and times specified above. It will involve the use of high speed power vessels which will be active in the area during the above times, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be marked by the presence of control vessels on the perimeter.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Edward River – near the Deniliquin Boat Club on Riverview Drive (Deniliquin) as follows:

- Downstream 300 metres of the Deniliquin Boat Club and adjacent to the land-based feature of the Warbreccan Homestead.

Detail

A wakeboarding competition will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Edward River, specified above. This will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow-lines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will be created at the location specified above. The zone will be marked by buoys and monitored by control and official Transport for NSW vessels. There will also be support vessels present to manage the event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the course via a 'transit lane'.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Marine Safety Act 1998, all vessels using the transit lane:

- Must not exceed the maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

Hunter River, Raymond Terrace – entire width of the river downstream from the Fitzgerald Bridge, between the prolongations of Bourke Street and Swan Street

Duration

9.00am to 5.00pm on the following dates:

- Sunday 30 January 2022
- Saturday 19 March 2022
- Sunday 20 March 2022
- Sunday 5 June 2022
- Sunday 3 July 2022
- Sunday 14 August 2022

Detail

A number of high speed power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Hunter River, Raymond Terrace at the dates and times specified above. It will involve the use of high speed power vessels which will be active in the area, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be indicated by control vessels stationed on and patrolling the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit Arrangements and Special Restrictions

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a 'transit lane'. Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Act, vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

REGULATION OF VESSELS – SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Tomaga River and adjoining waters of the Tasman Sea defined by:

- 1. The entirety of the Tomaga River from the Tomakin Boat Ramp to the Tomaga River Caravan Park Boat Ramp.
- 2. The waters of the Tasman Sea adjacent to Tomakin Beach and the landmark of Kingston Place, Tomakin.

Duration

• 9.00am to 2.30pm – Saturday 5 February 2022

Detail

The swim leg of a triathlon event will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Tomaga River and the Tasman Sea as specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will be indicated by the presence of course rounding buoys, with the zone extending for 50 metres outside the course rounding buoys on all sides.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are prohibited from entering the exclusion zone whilst it is in force.

Special Restrictions

Due to the risk to safe navigation and as a result of the nature of the event and number of participants, a Regulated Area will be created on the Tomaga River during the above times within which **Special Restrictions** are imposed.

The Regulated Area will comprise the full width of the Tomaga River, and will extend 200 metres ahead and 200 metres behind competitors (as indicated by the presence of control vessels) and will surround and move with the competitors over the length of the course. The perimeters of the Regulated Area will also be marked by buoys.

Pursuant to Section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, special restrictions are applicable to all **powered vessels** operating in the Regulated Area:

- Maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Minimal wash must be produced.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)
