## MENTAL HEALTH ACT 2007 Section 109 Declaration of mental health facility

- I, NIKKI MALONEY, Acting Executive Director of the Mental Health Branch, acting under delegation from the Secretary of the NSW Ministry of Health, and pursuant to section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*, DO HEREBY:
- (a) DECLARE the following premises of the Clinical Services Building (Building A) of Campbelltown Hospital, Therry Road, Campbelltown NSW 2560 to be a declared mental health facility for the purposes of the *Mental Health Act 2007*, comprising the following units:
  - Mental Health Short Stay Unit, Level 2
  - Adult Acute Mental Health Unit, Level 4
  - Mental Health Intensive Care Unit (MHICU), Level 4
  - Statewide Civil Mental Health Rehabilitation Unit, Level 5
  - Mental Health High Dependency Unit, Level 6
  - Young Adult Mental Health Unit, Level 7
  - Adolescent Mental Health Unit, Level 8
  - Older People's Mental Health Unit, Level 9; and
- (b) DECLARE the premises to be designated as a "mental health assessment and inpatient treatment" class facility.
