ORDER

Restoration of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* a direction has been issued that the Order that took effect on and from 1 October 2021, on **Mr Angus Gregory Naylor (PHA0002480012)** of Sutherland NSW 2232, prohibiting him as a pharmacist from supplying or having possession of, or manufacturing any preparation, admixture or extract of a drug of addiction as authorised by clauses 101(1) and 102 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 17 August 2022.

MENTAL HEALTH ACT 2007
Section 109
Declaration of mental health facility

I, BRENDAN FLYNN, Acting Executive Director of the Mental Health Branch, acting under delegation from the Secretary of the NSW Ministry of Health, and pursuant to section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*, DO HEREBY:

(a) DECLARE the following premises to be a declared mental health facility for the purposes of section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*:

- **Hunter Psychiatric Rehabilitation Service**, located at 20 Stewart Avenue, Hamilton South NSW 2303; and

(b) DECLARE this facility to be designated as a “community or health care agency” class facility; and

(c) RESTRICT this facility to the provision of services and performance of functions necessary for or associated with administration or management of community treatment orders under the following provisions of the *Mental Health Act 2007*:

- i. Part 3 of Chapter 3 (except for sections 61, 61A, 62 and 63);
- ii. Chapter 4; and
- iii. Chapter 5 (except for sections 111 and 112 and Division 2 of Part 2).

MENTAL HEALTH ACT 2007
Section 109
Declaration of Mental Health Facility

I, BRENDAN FLYNN, Acting Executive Director, Mental Health Branch, acting under delegation from the Secretary, NSW Ministry of Health, and pursuant to section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007* and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, DO HEREBY:

(a) REVOKE the Order published in the NSW Government Gazette No. 101 of 8 July 2009 page 4047, declaring the Hunter Valley Mental Health Service and the Hunter Psychiatric Rehabilitation Service to be declared mental health facilities in accordance with section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*; and

(b) DECLARE the following premises to be a declared mental health facility for the purposes of section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*:

- **Hunter Valley Mental Health Service**, located in the Old Maitland Mental Health Unit within the Old Maitland Hospital campus at 560 High Street, Maitland NSW 2320; and

(c) DECLARE this facility to be designated as “community or health care agency” class facility; and

(d) RESTRICT this facility to the provision of services and performance of functions necessary for or associated with administration or management of community treatment orders under the following provisions of the *Mental Health Act 2007*:

- i. Part 3 of Chapter 3 (except for sections 61, 61A, 62 and 63);
- ii. Chapter 4; and
- iii. Chapter 5 (except for sections 111 and 112 and Division 2 of Part 2)
