**Section 109**  
**Revocation of mental health facility**

**POISONS AND THERAPEUTIC  
GOODS REGULATION 2008**

ORDER

Withdrawal of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* an Order has been made on **Mr Samir Ibrahim (PHA0001340825)**, of Merrylands NSW 2160, prohibiting him, until further notice, as a pharmacist, from supplying or having possession of, or manufacturing any preparation, admixture, or extract of a drug of addiction as authorised by clauses 85, 99, 99A, 101(1) and 102 of the Regulation.

This Order is to take effect on and from 5 September 2022.
