Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 3) Amendment (No 1) Order 2022

under the

Public Health Act 2010

I, Brad Hazzard, the Minister for Health, make the following Order under the *Public Health Act* 2010, section 7.

Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to remove the requirement to wear fitted face coverings—

- (a) in an indoor area at a cruise terminal, or
- (b) at a public transport waiting area, or
- (c) in a vehicle or vessel being used to provide a public transport service.

This Order also removes redundant provisions from the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 3) Order 2022*.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 3) Amendment (No 1) Order 2022.

2 Commencement

This Order commences at the beginning of 21 September 2022.
