It is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor, has, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, this day assented to the under mentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 41 - An Act to make miscellaneous amendments to various Acts relating to health and associated matters. [Health Legislation (Miscellaneous) Amendment Bill (No 2)]

Act No. 42 — An Act to establish and confer functions on Museums of History NSW and repeal the *Historic Houses Act 1980*; to amend the *State Records Act 1998* to transfer certain functions of the State Archives and Records Authority of New South Wales to Museums of History NSW and consequently rename the Authority; and for other purposes. [Museums of History NSW Bill]
