Biosecurity (Varroa Mite) Emergency Amendment Order 2022 (No. 2)

1 Name of the Order

This Order is the *Biosecurity (Varroa Mite) Emergency Amendment Order 2022 (No. 2)*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day that it is published in the NSW Gazette.

3 Amendment of *Biosecurity (Varroa Mite) Emergency Order 2022 (No. 28)*

(1) Clause 37(6)

Omit clause. Insert instead:

- (6) Empty honey supers being moved under subclause (1)(b):
 - (a) can be transported back to the same hive from which they were removed, and placed on that hive, or
 - (b) can be placed on any other hive if they have been:
 - (i) stored in a bee-proof manner for 21 days, or
 - (ii) stored in cold storage at -15 degrees Celsius, or colder, for 72 hours.

(2) Clause 41(6)

Omit clause. Insert instead:

- (6) Empty honey supers being moved under subclause (1)(b):
 - (a) can be transported back to the same hive from which they were removed, and placed on that hive, or
 - (b) can be placed on any other hive if they have been:
 - (i) stored in a bee-proof manner for 21 days, or
 - (ii) stored in cold storage at -15 degrees Celsius, or colder, for 72 hours.

(3) Clause 43(3)(b)

Omit the words 'into and'.
