SUSPICIOUS DEATH

SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$750,000) REWARD

On the 13 October 1993, the naked body of Allison NEWSTEAD, aged 17 years, was located at the disused Pelton Colliery, approximately 8km from Cessnock, NSW. Allison had been reported missing on the 6 October 1993 and the circumstances of her death have been unable to be determined.

Notice is hereby given that a reward of up to five hundred thousand dollars (\$750,000) will be paid by the Government of New South Wales for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the suspicious death of Allison NEWSTEAD.

The allocation of this reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of Police.
