Act No. 63 — An Act to amend the Government Sector Finance Act 2018, the First Home Owner Grant (New Homes) Act 2000, the Superannuation Administration Act 1996, the Electricity Supply Act 1995, the Energy and Utilities Administration Act 1987 and the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989 for particular purposes; and to make consequential amendments to other Acts.
