The Handa Opera event will take place at Farm Cove on the dates specified above, and comprises a construction, performance, and deconstruction period.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event times listed at the above location, which will be marked by lit yellow buoys and indicated by the presence of control and security vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – Marine Safety Act 1998)



REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Murray River – near the township of Robinvale (Victoria) between the following locations:

- 7.00am to 2.00pm Saturday 12 March 2022 Murray River between the 1122km river marker (1km downstream of the Robinvale-Euston Road Bridge) and the 1164km river marker (junction of the Murray River and Bonvaricall Creek).
- 2.00pm to 7.00pm Saturday 12 March 2022 Murray River between the 1122km river marker (1km downstream of the Robinvale-Euston Road Bridge) and the 1140km river marker (2km upstream of the Bumbang Cutting).
- 7.00am to 7.00pm Sunday 13 March 2022 Murray River between the 1122km river marker (1km downstream of the Robinvale-Euston Road Bridge) and the 1164km river marker (junction of the Murray River and Bonvaricall Creek).

Duration

- 7.00am to 7.00pm Saturday 12 March 2022
- 7.00am to 7.00pm Sunday 13 March 2022

Detail

Competitive water ski racing will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Murray River as specified above.

The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow-lines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the full width of the Murray River between the locations above. The area will be marked by buoys and the presence of official patrol and control vessels. Unauthorised vessels and persons are prohibited from entering the exclusion zone during the event.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Wollongong Harbour and adjoining waters of the Tasman Sea defined by:

- 1. the shoreline adjacent to the intersection of Harbour Street and Cliff Road, to
- 2. the eastern side of the remnants of the stone structure adjacent to the Wollongong Slipway, to
- 3. the entrance into the Wollongong Harbour, to
- 4. a point extending approximately 50 metres off the continental pools and out to a point approximately 100m off the Southern break wall into the Tasman Sea.

Duration

• 8.00am to 11.30am – Sunday 6 March 2022

Detail

An aquathon event will be conducted at the location and on the date and time specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will be indicated by the presence of course rounding buoys, with the zone extending for 20 metres outside the course rounding buoys on all sides.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be patrolled by control vessels.


