# Fisheries Management (Yarrahapinni Wetlands Fishing Closure) Notification 2023

under the

Fisheries Management Act 1994

I, Sean Sloan, Deputy Director General Fisheries, with the delegated authority of the Minister and the Secretary under sections 227 and 228 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 (the Act) and under section 8 of that Act, give notice of the following fishing closure.

### Part 1 Preliminary

1. Name of Notification This notification is the Fisheries Management (Yarrahapinni Wetlands Fishing Closure) Notification 2023.

### 2. Commencement and duration

This notification commences on 2 March 2023 and will remain in force for a period of 5 years.

3. Definitions

In this notification:

*recreational fisher* means a fisher who takes fish by any method, otherwise than for sale.

*endorsement holder* has the same meaning as Clause 2 of the Estuary General Share Management Plan.

*Estuary General Fishery* means the share management fishery of that name, as described in Schedule 1 of the Act.

**Estuary General Share Management Plan** means the Fisheries Management (Estuary General Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006.

### Part 2 Fishing Closure

All recreational fishers and endorsement holders in the Estuary General Fishery are prohibited from taking fish in all waters within the Yarrahapinni Wetlands National Park and its creeks and tributaries extending upstream of a line drawn from the southwest entrance to Yarrahapinni Wetlands at 30 54.158'S, 152 59.200'E, then in a northerly direction for approximately 350 metres to the point 30 53.963'S, 152 59.245'E, then in an north-easterly direction for approximately 300 metres to the point 30 53.898'S, 152 59.414'E, and then in a south-easterly direction of approximately 210 metres to the eastern side of the rock revetment adjacent to Golden Hole.
