## The Draft Protected Specimens Code of Practice is available for community feedback

The Department of Planning and Environment is seeking feedback from the public on the Draft Protected Animal Specimens Code of Practice 2022. Under the proposed Code of Practice, some activities involving protected animal specimens will no longer require a Biodiversity Conservation Licence.

Public exhibition will be from **Friday 20 January to Sunday 19 February 2023.** During this time, you are invited to make a written submission by:
