REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Brisbane Water, Gosford – between Gosford Harbour breakwall and the railway bridge.

Duration

- 8.45pm to 9.45pm – Thursday 26 January 2023

Detail

A fireworks display will be conducted over the navigable waters of Brisbane Water, Gosford specified above. Fireworks will be launched from an anchored firing barge at the above location. The area directly around this location may be dangerous and hazardous during the fireworks display.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will extend for 300 metres around the firing barge and be monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

Millers Point, Sydney Harbour

Duration

8.00pm to 10.00pm – Tuesday 24 and Wednesday 25 January 2023

Detail

The Sydney Festival Vigil event is ceremonial in nature with a Welcome to Country and marks the return of Me-Mel to the Sydney Metropolitan Local Aboriginal Land Council. Me-Mel will act as a backdrop to the “performance area” which is a barge 40 m off Barangaroo Headland with a screen and PA on it. There will also be a moving ‘eel’ effect where a boom fitted with flares will be towed by a vessel

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by the presence of maritime control vessels as per the attached map.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

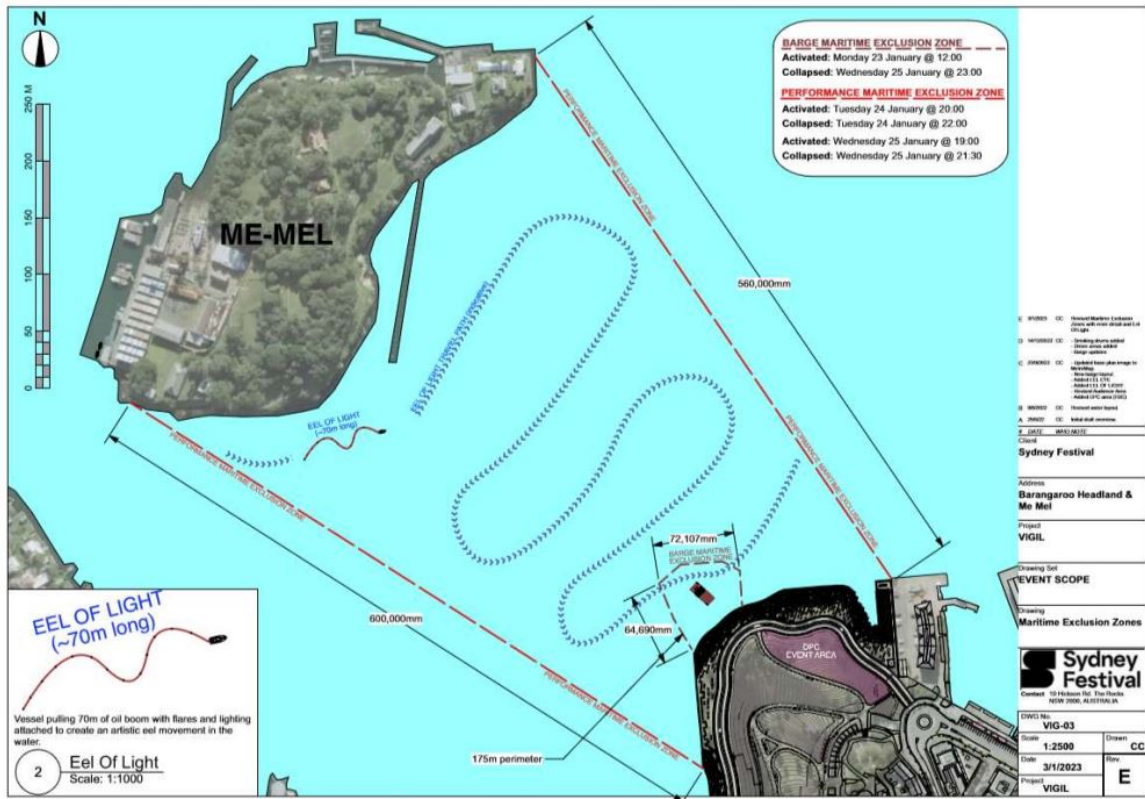

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Sydney Harbour – Sydney Harbour Bridge Transit Zone.

Duration

- 5.30am to 10.00am - Sunday 22 January 2023

Detail & Special Restrictions

A special event will take place on Sydney Harbour at the above location, being filming on the Sydney Harbour Bridge using a helicopter. To ensure the safety of navigation, a **Regulated Area** with declared special restrictions will be established at the location specified above.

Exclusion Zone

An Exclusion Zone is specified during the event, which will be established on either side of the Sydney Harbour Bridge during the above times, and will be enforced by Maritime control vessels, as per the attached map.

NO UNAUTHORISED VESSELS are to enter the Exclusion Zone, which will be patrolled by Transport for NSW patrol vessels and other control vessels.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONES AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Regulated Area

Sydney Harbour – from Goat Island to Steele Point, Vaucluse, comprising all navigable waters bounded by imaginary lines drawn from:

- Balls Head to Balmain immediately West of Goat Island (inclusive of Darling Harbour) and;
- Bradleys Head Light to Steele Point.

Duration

From 3:00pm Wednesday 25 January 2023 to 10:00pm Thursday 26 January 2023

Detail

The annual Australia Day celebration on Sydney Harbour - a special event conducted by the Department of Premier and Cabinet and Sydney Festival - will take place within the waters of the **regulated area** specified above. Due to the potential to affect the safety of navigation and in order to safeguard the special event, this Marine Notice issued by Transport for NSW establishes Special Restrictions and Exclusion Zones pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*.

Preparation phase – 25 January 2023

From 3:00pm until 10:00pm on Wednesday 25 January 2023, vessel operators authorised to use Sydney Cove are to navigate with extreme caution and must comply with advice and instructions from Maritime Control, Sydney VTS and Maritime control vessels.

A barge, yachts, personal watercraft and support vessels will be engaged in preparation for the event in Sydney Cove. Entry and exit to Sydney Cove will be limited and wharf restrictions will apply at times when critical moves are being conducted.

Exclusion Zones - 26 January 2023

Strict Exclusion Zones will be established in the regulated area at designated times (see detail below). These zones will be enforced by Maritime and Police patrol vessels and may also be marked by a perimeter of yellow buoys.

- 7:30am to 10:30am** - Sydney Harbour Splash – a static exclusion zone marked by yellow buoys from Milk Beach to Woollahra Sailing Club. This exclusion zone marks the course of a charity swim, and may have a Maritime patrol vessel in attendance;
- 8:00am to 2:00pm** - a moving exclusion zone forming a perimeter 200 metres ahead and 60 metres either side and astern of HMAS Sydney while the vessel is underway between the Overseas Passenger Terminal, Garden Island and Sydney Heads;
- 10.45am to 11:30am** - a moving exclusion zone forming a perimeter of 50 metres around the bow, sides and stern of the “Emerald Class” ferries participating in the ‘Ferrython’ as they navigate on a course between Farm Cove, Rose Bay and the Sydney Harbour Bridge;

- (d) **11:45am to 12:30pm** – a static exclusion zone between imaginary lines drawn from Milsons Point Ferry Wharf and Pier One at Dawes Point (west of the Sydney Harbour Bridge), and from the Sydney Opera House to Kirribilli Point, and Kirribilli Point to Milsons Point. This exclusion zone also incorporates Sydney Cove and will be in place for the ‘Salute to Australia’. This zone will be marked by the presence of Maritime and other official patrol vessels on the perimeter;
- (e) **1.00pm to 1:30pm** - a moving exclusion zone forming a perimeter of 50 metres around the bow, sides and stern of the Tall Ships participating in the ‘Tall Ships Race’ as they sail on a course from Bradleys Head north of Fort Denison to the Sydney Harbour Bridge;
- (f) **7:30pm to 10:00pm** – an exclusion zone in Sydney Cove extending from the northern end of Pier 2/3 at Dawes Point to the Red Diamond marking the centre of the Sydney Harbour Bridge then southeast to a point between Kirribilli Point and the port lateral marker off the Sydney Opera House. This exclusion zone will be marked by lit yellow buoys and Maritime patrol vessels. All vessels navigating through this area must pass north of the exclusion zone. All authorised vessels already within the Cove must follow the directions from Maritime patrol vessels and - if moving - must pass at a safe distance from any fireworks barges and tugs (or remain alongside). No unauthorised vessels will be permitted to enter or depart Sydney Cove between these times. Commercial vessels and those taking part in the event may be permitted to stop and drift in the Sydney Harbour Transit Zone but must follow directions from patrol vessels. A second line of buoys between Milsons Point and Kirribilli Point will mark a waiting area to the north for vessels participating in the event;
- (g) **All times** – a moving exclusion zone is in place 500 metres ahead and 30 metres either side or astern of any seagoing ships while underway, and within 30 metres of ships when at anchor or moored within Sydney Harbour.

NO UNAUTHORISED VESSELS OR PERSONS are to enter the Exclusion Zones under any circumstances. The regulated area will be patrolled by Police, Maritime, and other official patrol vessels.

The above times may be extended without notice by Transport for NSW in the interests of public safety. Entry of unauthorised vessels or persons into the Exclusion Zone renders the vessel operator or person liable to an offence.

Note: Provided that vessels remain outside the Exclusion Zones (and despite any existing signposted regulation), vessels are permitted to stop or drift within the Sydney Harbour Transit Zone from 11:45am to 12:30pm and 7:30pm to 10:00pm on 26 January 2023. In addition, a buoyed spectator area will be established in the vicinity of Jeffrey Street Wharf during the day to allow registered Harbour Parade entrants and small vessels to anchor or drift so spectators may watch the events.

Special Restrictions – 26 January 2023

Within the regulated area (but outside the exclusion zones), the following Special Restrictions apply:

- (a) A **Speed Limit of 6 knots** applies to all non-participating vessels within 200m of any Exclusion Zone for the duration of the events. Maximum Penalty \$1,100.00 (*Marine Safety Act 1998 s.12(5)*);
- (b) A “**No Wash Zone**” will be enforced within 200m of any Exclusion Zone for the duration of the events. Maximum Penalty \$1,100.00 (*Marine Safety Act 1998 s 12(5)*).
- (c) Certain commuter and commercial vessel wharves will not be accessible during various Exclusion Zone times. Operators should check availability prior to approaching a wharf.

Offence Provision

Transport for NSW advises that any vessel operator or person

- breaching the Special Restrictions detailed above; or
- entering an Exclusion Zone

is liable to an offence (*Marine Safety Act 1998 s.12(5)* - Maximum Penalty \$1,100.00)

Hawkesbury River, Windsor – entire width of the river between Windsor Reach and Governor Phillip Park.

Duration

- 8.30pm to 9.30pm – Thursday 26 January 2023

Detail

A fireworks display will be conducted over the navigable waters of the Hawkesbury River, Windsor specified above. Fireworks will be launched from an anchored firing barge at the above location. The area directly around this location may be dangerous and hazardous during the fireworks display.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will extend for 100 metres around the firing barge. The Zone will also be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Warners Bay, Belmont Bay, Fishing Point – Lake Macquarie

Duration

- 8.30pm to 9.30pm – Saturday 28 January 2023

Detail

A fireworks display will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Macquarie specified above. Fireworks will be launched from a moored firing barge at the above location. The area directly around this firing position may be dangerous and hazardous to other waterway users while fireworks are being launched.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will extend 200 metres around the moored barge and be indicated by the presence of control vessels stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Richmond River, Woodburn - Court Street Road Bridge.

Duration

- 7.00pm to 9.00pm – Thursday 26 January 2023

Detail

A fireworks display will be conducted over the navigable waters of the Richmond River, Woodburn specified above. Fireworks will be launched from the Court Street Road Bridge and the area directly around this firing position may be dangerous and hazardous during the event.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, extending for a radius of 75 metres around the firing position. The Zone will also be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit Lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a 'transit lane'.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Act, vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).
