It is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor, has, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, this day assented to the under mentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 15 — An Act to amend the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* to make it unlawful to vilify a person or group of persons on the ground of religious belief or affiliation or religious activity. **[Anti-Discrimination Amendment (Religious Vilification) Bill]**

Act No. 16 — An Act to amend the *State Insurance and Care Governance Act 2015* to provide for the appointment of directors nominated by employee and employer bodies to the ICNSW Board. **[State Insurance and Care Governance Amendment (ICNSW Board) Bill]**
