4 Exemption

Drivision Pty Ltd is exempt from the requirement under section 31(3)(c) of the Act that at least one of its directors or managers nominated for the purposes of Part 3 of the Act is a resident of New South Wales subject to the condition at clause 5.

5 Condition

The nominated director or manager's residence must be located within the Australian Capital Territory.

Note: An exemption that is conditional ceases to have effect if the condition is not observed.

4 Exemption

Tweed Heads Coolangatta Taxi Service Pty. Ltd. is exempt from the requirement under section 31(3)(c) of the Act that at least one of its directors or managers nominated for the purposes of Part 3 of the Act is a resident of New South Wales subject to the condition at clause 5.

5 Condition

The nominated director or manager's residence must be located within 10 kilometres of the New South Wales border.

Note: An exemption that is conditional ceases to have effect if the condition is not observed.

Explanatory note

This Order is the *Point to Point Transport (Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services) Exemption Order* 2023.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the date it is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

3 Interpretation

Words and expressions in this Order have the same meaning as in the *Point to Point Transport* (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016 or the *Point to Point Transport* (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017 unless otherwise stated.

Act means the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016.

Regulation means the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017.

Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services means Crimina Pty. Ltd. (trading as Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services).

4 Exemptions

Subject to the conditions in clause 5, Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services is exempt from the following requirements:

- the requirement under Part 4 of the Act that the motor vehicles used to provide a taxi service are motor vehicles for which Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services, or an employee, contractor or affiliated provider of Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services must hold a licence under section 47 of the Act; and
- the requirement under section 31(3)(c) of the Act that at least one of its directors or managers nominated for the purposes of Part 3 of the Act is a resident of New South Wales.

5 Conditions

- 5.1 Motor vehicles used by Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services to provide a taxi service must comply with the *Commercial Passenger Vehicle Industry Act 2017* (Victoria) and the *Commercial Passenger Vehicle Industry Regulations 2018* (Victoria).
- 5.2 Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services must ensure that the drivers of the motor vehicles used to provide a taxi service, comply with the following clauses of the Regulation:
 - Cl 24 (disqualifying offences)
 - Cl 25 (ineligible drivers)
 - Cl 59 (driver not to smoke in vehicle)
 - Cl 60 (offensive behaviour by drivers)
 - Cl 63 (additional passengers)
 - Cl 64 (assistance animals)
 - Cl 66 (no touting or soliciting for passengers)
 - Cl 70 (driver to supply information on hirings)
 - Cl 71 (driver to hand over driver licence for inspection)
 - Cl 74 (interference with safety devices)
 - Cl 75 (standing otherwise than in a taxi zone)
 - Cl 76 (use of taxi zones)
 - Cl 81 (operation of fare calculation device)
- 5.3 Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services continues to be authorised under Part 3 of the Act to provide a taxi and booking service.
- 5.4 Motor vehicles used by Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services to provide a taxi service must not ply or stand for hire in New South Wales other than in the township of Barham
- 5.5 The nominated director or manager's residence must be located within 40 kilometres of the New South Wales border.

Note: An exemption that is conditional ceases to have effect if the condition is not observed.

Explanatory note

This Exemption Order exempts Crimina Pty. Ltd. (trading as Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services) from:

- the requirement that the motor vehicles used by Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services to provide a taxi service, are motor vehicles for which Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services, or an employee, contractor or affiliated provider of Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Services, is the holder of a taxi licence issued under Part 4 of the Act; and
- the requirement under section 31(3)(c) of the Act that at least one of its nominated directors or managers for the purposes of Part 3 of the Act is a resident of New South Wales.

This notice supersedes the previous exemption notice pertaining to Cohuna & Koondrook Taxi Service published in the NSW Government Gazette No 38 of 26 April 2019 at pages 1239 – 1240.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Lake Mulwala – near the locality of the Mulwala Water Ski Club and within an area bounded by:

- The Mulwala foreshore between the entrance of the Mulwala Canal and south to the Melbourne Street Bridge, then
- East into Lake Mulwala for a distance of approximately 750 metres, then
- North for a distance of approximately 2.5km to a location directly east of the entrance of the Mulwala Canal, then
- West to the entrance of the Mulwala Canal.

Duration

7.30am to 5.00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 26 August 2023
- Sunday 27 August 2023

Detail

Water Ski Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Mulwala involving the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow lines and the possibility of persons in the water from time to time, presenting a potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is declared during the event at the location specified above, which will be marked by buoys and be monitored and maintained by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

TRANSIT LANE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

A 'transit lane' will be established along the foreshore from the Lake Mulwala Holiday Park, south of the Mulwala Water Ski Club, to the Melbourne Street bridge, Mulwala, within which an authorised control vessel may, at times during the event, authorise local vessel traffic to pass through and within the confines of the transit lane.

SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS apply to vessels using the transit lane. Vessels navigating the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

Detail

A special event will take place on Sydney Harbour in Farm Cove. The event will involve a drone show where a swarm of drones will briefly hover at low level over Sydney Harbour displaying images using lights.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will be south of an imaginary line between the South of Man O'War Wharf and the northern tip of Mrs Macquaries Point (as per the attached map). The Exclusion Zone will be monitored by Maritime and control vessels.

If the event proceeds on Saturday 26 August 2023, the Exclusion Zone will not be activated on Friday 25 August 2023 and will be dispensed with.
