#### **REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE**

#### Location

Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga – all navigable waters

#### **Duration**

- 8:00am to 5:00pm Saturday 23 September 2023
- 8:00am to 5:00pm Sunday 24 September 2023

#### **Detail**

Power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Albert as specified above. The event will involve the use of high-speed power vessels, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of Lake Albert, which will effectively close the Lake to all other vessel use between the above times for this event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone which will be maintained and monitored by control vessels.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998).

#### **REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE**

#### Location

Hawkesbury River – between Upper Half Moon Bend and Wisemans Ferry

#### **Duration**

8:00am to 5:00pm - Sunday, 24 September 2023

#### **Detail**

A high-speed water ski race event will be held on the navigable waters of the Hawkesbury River as specified above. Tuggerah Lake, The Entrance – adjacent to Memorial Park.

#### **Duration**

8:45pm to 9:45pm – Saturday 30 September 2023

#### **Detail**

Firework displays will be conducted over the navigable waters of Tuggerah Lake, as specified above and will be launched from a fireworks barge anchored at the location. The area directly around this firing position may be dangerous and hazardous while fireworks are being launched.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be marked by the presence of control vessels on the perimeter and will be created 150 meters around the fireworks barge.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone, which will be monitored by control vessels.

#### 1 Name of Notice

This Notice is the *Electric Scooter Use Area Exemption (Wollongong City Council) Notice 2023.* 

#### 2 Commencement

This Notice has effect on and from 25 September 2023.

#### 3 Effect

This Notice remains in force up to and including the repeal of Part 15 of the Road Rules 2014 unless revoked or amended earlier.

#### 4 Interpretation

Words and expressions used in this Notice have the same meaning as in the Road Rules 2014 unless otherwise stated.

#### 5 Exemption of the operation of road rule 262-1

Riders of electric scooters are exempt from road rule 262-1 on roads within Wollongong City Council indicated by the shaded area (defined as "Operational Area" in the Legend) at Schedule One to this Notice.

#### 6 Publication

This Notice is to be published in the NSW Government Gazette.

#### **Explanatory note:**


Road rule 262-1 prohibits the riding of electric scooters on a road unless those riders are exempt by a Notice made by Transport for NSW under road rule 262-2 which specifies an area included in the Notice.

Only persons 16 years and over may legally ride an electric scooter borrowed or hired under a share scheme and are also subject to other road transport laws including specific road rules for electric scooter riders at Part 15-1 of the Road Rules 2014 (including riding an electric scooter on a road on which the ordinary speed limit is greater than 50 kilometres per hour).


# Wollongong E-Scooter Shared Scheme Trial Map




