Act No. 21 — An Act to amend the *Crimes Act 1900* in relation to corrupt benefits for trustees and others. [Crimes Amendment (Corrupt Benefits for Trustees) Bill]

Act No. 22 — An Act to make miscellaneous amendments to the *Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act 2013* following a statutory review. **[Civil and Administrative Tribunal Amendment Bill]** 

Act No. 23 — An Act to make miscellaneous amendments to the *Explosives Act 2003*. **[Explosives Amendment Bill]**
