Water ski shows will be conducted at the location at the dates and times specified above. The events will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow lines and the possibility of persons in the water from time to time, presenting a potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the events at the location and will be indicated by the presence of control vessels, event officials, temporary buoyage (event dependent) and signage located at the Mulwala Ski Club boat ramp and foreshore.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.
