REGULTION OF VESSELS – SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Darling River, from the Menindee Weir downstream to the Murray River junction

Duration

12:00am Friday 3 February 2023 until 11.59pm Friday 23 February 2023.

Special Restrictions

Due to high river levels and flooding presenting a risk to the safety of navigation **Special Restrictions** are imposed as follows:

- (a) A Speed Limit of 4 knots applies to all vessels;
- (b) Towing of persons is prohibited;
- (c) Vessels must produce minimal wash.

Revocation

Marine Notice SO2214 published in NSW Government Gazette no.10 of 13 January 2023 is revoked.

Penalties may apply (section 11(4) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

NOTE: Some specific locations may be subject to additional restrictions or prohibitions imposed by the NSW State Emergency Service under the *State Emergency Services Act1989*.

REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Kendalls Beach to Easts Beach, Kiama - stretch of coastline approximately 2 kilometres long between the two beaches

Duration

7.00am to 10.30am – Saturday 11 February 2023

Detail

The Elite Energy Ocean Swim will take place on the navigable waters of Kendalls Beach and Easts Beach specified above. It will consist of 3 separate races that are 4 kilometres long (Kendalls Beach to East Beach and return), 2 kilometres long (East Beach to Kendalls Beach), and 500 metres long (Kendalls Beach).

Exclusion Zone

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be indicated by the presence of course rounding buoys and will extend 50 metres outside the course rounding buoys on all sides.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Special Restrictions

Due to the risk to safe navigation and as a result of the nature of the event and number of participants, a Regulated Area will be created at Kendalls Beach, Easts Beach and the adjoining coastline between the above times within which **Special Restrictions** are imposed.

The Regulated Area will extend 200 metres ahead and 200 metres behind competitors (as indicated by the presence of control vessels) and will surround and move with the competitors over the length of the course. The perimeters of the Regulated Area will also be marked by buoys.

Pursuant to Section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, **powered vessels** operating in the Regulated Area:

- Must not exceed the maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce minimal wash.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Wollondilly River— the entirety of the river between 900 metres upstream and 700 metres downstream of the Copford Reach boat ramp, near the township of Goulburn.

Duration

- 7:30am to 7:00pm Saturday 4 February 2023
- 8:30am to 1:00pm Sunday 5 February 2023

Detail

A competitive water ski tournament will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Wollondilly River as specified above. The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels, persons being towed at speed using towlines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise of the entirety of the Wollondilly River between the locations detailed above. The exclusion zone will be monitored by event staff and a control vessel.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.
