## FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLAR (\$500,000) REWARD

On 11 March 2002, Iain Stewart HOGG, aged 46 years, was reported missing to Queensland Police. Iain has not been seen or heard from since and his body has never been located. Evidence suggests that Iain has been with foul play and may have been murdered in Tweed Heads, NSW.

Notice is hereby given that a reward of up to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) will be paid by the Government of New South Wales for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the disappearance/murder of Iain Stewart HOGG.

The allocation of this reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of Police.
